Now that I have arrived back in Washington, I wanted to jot off this quick note to express my sincere gratitude for the outstanding support that Embassy Tokyo provided to me as well as to Secretary Perry and the various DOD visitors. In particular, I wanted to single out the work of Neil Silver and his staff in the Political Section, especially Jim Pierce, Dave Shear, and the others who worked so hard on my visit. Serving as a control officer is often a thankless task, but -- as always -- Tokyo's standards remain very high.

2. As I write this, I would be remiss if I were to ignore the substantive and political success of the Perry trip. The sustained hard work of the Embassy during the last two years -- particularly during the last 12 months, when our bilateral dialogue focused on Okinawa -- was an indispensable part of this accomplishment. Moreover, in the broader view, you all have played a major role in achieving a U.S. foreign policy success of historic consequence: the reaffirmation of our relationship with

the most important U.S. ally in Asia, the assurance of the long term viability of that alliance, and the launching of a bilateral effort to re-shape cooperation between our militaries to fit the realities of the next century. My hat is off to all of you.

3. This was probably my last visit to Tokyo as Assistant Secretary. I will leave office with the view, as recently expressed by Secretary Christopher to Foreign Minister Ikeda that our bilateral relationship with Japan is now as

good as it has ~~been in 25 years~~. Your tireless efforts have helped to make this possible, and I am pleased that I have had the opportunity to work closely with all of you in contributing to this endeavor. With Best Regards.
