## DETAILED DESCRIPTION

### Portrait Files

The portrait files include both formal and candid photographs of Humphrey alone, engaged in activities ranging from making speeches to relaxing with hobbies at home. These files are arranged chronologically by decade. They also include a group of portraits of people other than Humphrey or his family, such as celebrities, political figures, and friends.

### **Career Files**

The career files are by far the most extensive and detailed segment of the collection. They are arranged chronologically and follow a basic format that is repeated for each year, although the type and number of categories varies from year to year. The format is: Humphrey with important people; Humphrey with groups of people; media appearances; Humphrey and issues in which he was closely involved during his career; and events (visits to cities and universities, foreign travels, campaigns, etc.).
