Hill to Hon. W. E. Smith, Plattsburg, N.Y.

"We are now taking our share of the Montana cattle and sheep shipments... We expect to have the line finished into Great Falls tomorrow evening and will go on at once with the Montana Central. "Both President Cleveland and Col. Lamont enquired particularly about you... The Presidential reception was very good and the parties were greatly pleased, however, I think Mrs. C. had the most friends. The Presidents deliberate movements do not create much enthusiasm among the people."
