Hill to Hon. J.K.Cowen, Pres., B & O Road carbon  
Pres. Schwab of Carnegie Co. was here "looking  
over his iron matters and I had an interview  
with him here in regard to coal as return  
freight for their cars and boats, which take  
[iron] ore from Lake Superior to Pittsburgh...  
I find that they own a large coal field on the  
West side of the Monongahela River into which  
they are building a railway. They also own all  
of the Forty thousand acres of the Connells-  
ville coking coal, and Mr. Schwab indicated  
their intention of building ... to the Connells-  
ville field... would practically parallel the  
line of the Baltimore and Ohio... I asked Mr.

Schwab why he did not take up with the Baltimore and Ohio ... a ( ) e on his coal...."He seemed willing to do so .
