"A Col. [James] Baker here a few days since interviewed me on the subject of coal N.W. of Great Falls; it is called Crow's Nest in Kootenay, B. C. He brought me specimens of this coal which looked well, and told me that he had had some interviews with you and was now going out to see you. I think the Cannel coal that he exhibited to me is the same coal you showed me at St. Paul. It certainly has a vast amount of Bituminous substance in it and ought to be magnificent for gas purposes."
