Discusses the bad and even dangerous ^{position} (from gas in the mines) of the Company, which must be remedied. Desirable, however, to keep it Canadian. Suggests Dan Davies as mine supt. to replace Lindsey, who has been paid far too much for so little actual coal mining experience; he could well be made the company's lawyer. Grandby Co. of Grand Forks, B.C., is largest copper works in B.C. (or Canada), yet can't get enough coke for its plant; tried to get Hill, therefore to join in purchase of other coal lands and creation of a coal & coke co.; but Hill persuaded them to remain with the Coal Nest Pass Co.
