Re the Galt railroad between Great Falls and Lethbridge. We must build north and south to eliminate two sides of a triangle between Great Falls and Kalispell, since our traffic is increasing so rapidly. "We are acquiring a large coal field East of the Rocky Mountains near the international boundary line, which has been entirely overlooked and which will practically give us control of the cheap coke for smelting between Great Falls and the Coast. This [is].. additional reason why we should take the Galt road without delay."
