"I wish very much that I could make the plans for the St. Paul Cathedral. My reasons for wanting this are rather special and peculiar. I have done a great deal of church work, among other things being engaged in the building of the great Protestant Episcopal Cathedral here, St. John the Divine but although I have built one or two rather important Catholic churches, such as St. Matthews in Washington D. C. and the Blessed Sacrament in Providence, R. I., the
