Re Rosser and townsite speculation by Canadian Pacific Road officials and men. Van Horne is not involved, nor is Stickney. "Van Horne will close contract with Col. Jack Caseman who built a large part of the Union Pacific for the grading of the 500 or 600 miles this summer at prices nearly as low as Shepards first offer. Shepard & Langdon were ready to modify their bid to about 27½ and 35¢ but would not go as low as Caseman."
