Hill to Lucious F. Hubbard, Gov. of Minnesota

Asks for swamplands under the charter of the Minneapolis and St. Cloud Railroad Company, since Manitoba Road has ready for passage of cars "its line of railroad from St. Cloud ... to Hinckley... to a junction with the St. Paul & Duluth Railroad Company - formerly the Lake Superior and Mississippi Railroad -- at said Hinckley, under act of the legislature of the state of Minnesota approved March 3, 1869 and entitled, "act to extend the time ... for the completion of a branch of the Minneapolis and St. Cloud RR. St. P. M. & M. Letter Book 6.831 (3/24/82-4/23/83)
