Hill to Postmaster Gen. G.B. Cortelyou

We have carried Spokane and Seattle mail for nearly 12 yrs. During the ARU Ry strike in 1894 our road was the only line carrying mails to the Pac. Coast, and the California mails were carried by us without additional compensation. Recent change made without fair time notice, which would have transferred mails carried by us to the Union Pacific, had we not learned of change from other sources. May we not ask that we have a chance to be heard if any further changes are contemplated?
