Rogers [who had just wired Hill through Lamont sending Wm.Scallen's report on "bad" political situation in Cascade County, Montana, where Hill's coal camp has a rabid Clark man as foreman] wires he has just received a wire from Butte that "we will need all 140 votes of his employes at Butte and that unless he here causes active work to be done by his bosses among his men in Valley County, Republicans will lose that County.
