Hill to Kennedy

Encloses Major Roger's report of his work in the Rocky Mountains at the head of Sun River mountain. "It is of great value to us to know just what is ahead of us and I expect to keep Major Rogers at work until we know all the country between Sun River Valley and the Columbia or Puget Sound. Also valuable in case another Company was seeking to occupy that country." Broadwater told me on his visit here that he has found a very good line between Red Mt. and Butte. Northern Pacific received at Helena station for first 9 mos. of present yr. \$750,000 cash, which doesn't include receipts of local

tickets uptown in Helena. I have Daley's statement showing money paid [redacted] Anaconda Co. from January 1, 1885 to July 1, 1886, \$2,150,000.
