

Rose, Sir John

1876

Governor of the Hudson's Bay Company and a member of the firm of Morton, Rose & Co. In march, 1876 Donald A. Smith thought he might interest Rose in acquiring the bonds of the First Division and the St. Vincent's Extension of the St. Paul & Pacific R.R. In 1877 George Stephen tried to interest Rose in investing money in this railroad. Rose's company in England employed their branch in New York to examine the railroad property. They sent General Winslow to do so.
