"We are beginning to realize the benefit of the direct operation of the Sioux City and Northern and Nebraska lines. Yesterday we had about forty cars of corn from that line for the head of Lake Superior. The greatest increase in our business however is in the through business to and from the West end, and the time is not far distant when the West end will furnish the largest part of the business of the entire System except the iron tonnage from North of Lake Superior."
