Judge [Greenleaf] Clark has been hired to assist Bigelow in drafting the mortgage. Re Kennedy's sale of Hill's Canadian Pacific stock. Dangers from the Grangers. "We will have quite a strong Granger element in our Minn. Legislature. I have been spending much time seeing that "good Railroad Committees [are] appointed in our state & think we will not

have any serious trouble.
