

Re Stubbs' letter. "He is evidently under the impression that Mr. Harriman and myself have made some other agreement or had some other or further agreement than that of the Metropolitan Club at which both you and himself were present. . . . The questions discussed covered three main points: first the Wallula and Portland traffic from Northern Pacific and Great Northern Lines. Second, the joint occupation of the Snake River Country, and Third, the access of Union Pacific to Puget Sound ports of Olympia, Tacoma and Seattle."
