Correspondence over a period of five years (Jany 11 & Dec. 15, 1888, Sept 3, 1889, April 10 & May 13, 1893) re buikding a railroad from Lake Superior southwestward through Wis., Minn. (Twin Cities), n.w. part of Iowa, & Neb., Kan. & Col., & perhaps N.M., Ariz. & Cal, to be called the Lake Superior & Southwestern Ry. Co.; also re sitting for his (Hill's) portrait by Matthew Wilson of N.Y., who has painted Walker & his wife; also re the coming panic of 1893, which he predicts accurately.
