Hill to J.S. Kennedy

Details of transportation of wheat by Hill's railroad and estimate of "18,000,000 bushels as against of 13,800,000 ~~last~~ year." Agrees with Kennedy's suggestion of "keeping our own counsel and publishing as little as possible of our doings." Railroad has received a deed of 85,000 acres "of Hinckley lands and hope to collect \$100,000 cash on account of their sales in next 60 days."
