Farley is still away; the elevator is building at Minneapolis and the elevator Co. here has bought the ground above Rice St. and advertised to build at once an elevator with capacity of 750,000 bu. Asked us to take stock but I told them we would have no connection with any business where Willius and Prince are directors; re Sahlgard suit [both W. and P. were evidently pressing that case] and Willius' desire to end it; "Prince now says he did not really understand the matter and was led into it &c. and professes to be anxious have it ended."
