The local business of the line should furnish enough revenue to make it a paying investment, and its through business ... cannot fail to make the enterprise a good one, as it will be able to furnish cheaper lumber and coal to the southwest than any other line and will be in a position to handle the agricultural products of Minnesota and Iowa on as good terms as the best."
