**HISTORY OF CENTRAL LAKES EDUCATION DISTRICT NO. 61-6022, WILLMAR**

Central Lakes Education District was established in September 1988 under Minn. Stat. 122.91 [Education District Legislation] to increase educational opportunities for learners by increasing cooperation and coordination among school districts, other governmental units, and post-secondary institutions, and to replace other existing cooperative structures. Specific goals of the district were the creation of gifted and talented programs for junior and senior high students, construction of programs for students at risk, enhancement of special education services, establishment of a multicultural and gender fair curriculum, and creation of an interactive instructional television network to serve all high schools within the education district.

The independent school districts involved were No. 341, Atwater, No. 345, New London-Spicer, No. 346, Raymond, No. 347, Willmar, No. 464, Grove City, No. 736, Belgrade-Elrosa, No. 737, Brooten, No. 775, Kerkhoven-Murdock-Sunburg, No. 127, Maynard, and No. 126, Clara City.

The district dissolved on September 15, 1999.
