SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE RECORDS

Subject files of Doug Peterson, a Democratic-Farmer-Laborite who served as State Representative for Minnesota's 13B and 20A Districts (Big Stone, Chippewa, Lac qui Parle, and Swift counties) from 1990 through 2002. The files include correspondence, newspaper clippings, notes, photographs, diagrams, legislative bills, minutes, and related materials documenting his service, particularly his interest in ethanol, feedlots, snowmobiles, the Right to Be Rural Coalition, and 1997 flood relief. A number of files relate to his role as co-chair of the 1997 House Ways & Means Flood Relief Task Force.
