ORIGINATING FROM HOLLYWOOD - OCTOBER 26

Thank you, Mr. Lawson.

We Americans are just six days away from a great  
decision.

We are going to choose a President of the United  
States----we are going to <sup>elect</sup>~~choose~~ a Congress----and as we do  
so we shall resolve the history of a decade----we shall  
determine the history of the world in our time.

This ~~weight~~ burden of decision has not suddenly been  
thrust upon us.

This generation was born to it and the welfare of  
the world today has been wrought by the United States.

At the polls next Tuesday, we shall secure that  
welfare, or expose it to new dangers. >

Our world today shivers in an armed and uneasy truce.

Shall that become a real and enduring peace?

Or shall we plunge back into the chaos from which we have just delivered ourselves?

< Our country is trembling in the course of a breathless inflation.

Shall that be turned into a stable and prosperous economy?

Or shall we be hurled into a new and more terrible depression?

These are great issues----and they call for plain talk----~~this is no time for pretty little amenities.~~

The Democratic Administration has met these issues---- and has dealt with them.

<sup>t</sup>hat administration gave our country and our world the Marshall Plan----the only program for peace that has worked in this century.

If we should reject the President and his administration, we should by the same ballot reject <sup>Secretary</sup>~~General~~ Marshall.

Shall his place be taken by some carefully  
hand-picked miniature statesman?

President Truman more than four years ago--when he  
was a member of the Senate----went to work upon the problem  
of restoring our American economy to a stable peace time  
operation.

We have heard much of the mistakes that he has  
made----and it is true----he made ~~some~~ *some - who has not?*

I say we shall fare better with a President who  
DOES something----when something must be done----than in the
