Made at his first stop, in Italy, the films show Senator Humphrey conferring with Admiral Robert P. Briscoe, Commander in Chief, Allied Forces, Southern Europe -- who is the NATO Commander with full responsibility for defense of the Middle East. Shown with Sehator Humphrey and Admiral Briscoe is Major General J. S. Upham, Chief of Staff, who is also a United States officer on assignment to NATO. While in the Roma-Naples area, Senator Humphrey had an audience with the Roman Catholic pontiff,

Pope Pius XII, whom he termed a "very great spiritual leader" and to whom he gave the greetings of the people of Minnesota.
