EXCERPTS FROM ADDRESS BY SENATOR HUBERT H. HUMPHREY

DFL CONVENTION

May 21, 1

We have had eight years of progressive deterioration of the powerful nathat held the unquestioned leadership of the world in 1952.

The great diplomatic disaster at the summit was something that by the slogic of events was bound to come sooner or later. The policies of Conservation Government, given sufficient time, have had their inevitable result. Like a tragedy, act by act, the Debacle at Paris was almost foreordained.

It was only a question of the precise time and place and circumstances which the elaborate public relations facade of the Republican administration would come crashing into ruin.

You cannot expect fair play, decency, and a help hand from the coldly dedicated enemies of our nation. When we stumble we can expect only an onrush of the wolves. When we falter we can expect only the slash at the national jucular vein.

The fatal flaw of Conservative Government is that in its narrow preoccupation with preserving things as they are, it cannot or will not recognize the world is in great and powerful ferment, that the challenge of Soviet power is in deadly earnest, and that the slogans and shibboleths of 19th century Republicanism cannot substitute for fearless and imaginative executive leaders

There has been no sense of direction, no will, no dedication, no purpos for eight years.

Coming in second-best has become a habit.

Reacting, instead of initiating, has become the natural order of things for our government.

There has been for eight years no consistent coordination of foreign policy with the planning of our Armed Forces, no effort to weld together a total national policy to deal with the enormous threat to world peace.

For eight years the main work of the idea men in the Republican Party have been to cover up, to explain away, to gloss over the incompetence and mismanage ment, the confusion and hesitation of the administration.

Public relations has become a way of life. It has created the great illusion that all was well in our domestic and international affairs. It has blurred the truth. It has substitued popularity for leadership, mediocrity for principle.

American prestige and leadership that once stood unchallenged, has falle so low in eight years that the President of the United States can be publicly a brutally humiliated.

I do not wish to imply that the world is come to an end, that we should be wringing our hands and heading for the bomb shelters because of the Debacle Paris.

Rather this should be a time of calm and dispassionate assessment. Ther must be time to let the dust settle, to permit a cooling-off period. We must n permit ourselves to be panicked or stampeded.

Above all, we must realize that there is no single stroke that can once again restore the American position. This climactic event at Paris has occured for many and complex reasons.

Only be a completely fresh approach to the task of national leadership, ily be a liberal government prepared to do what is necessary for American survival can we expect to begin the repair of the disaster.

I have been critical of the manner in which the prestige of our nation was laid on the block in recent weeks of the incredible series of actions and statements that gave the Soviet dictator the weapon he needed to attack our position and to wreck the summit meeting. I have requested that the appropriate committees of the Congress receive a full and detailed report from the executive branch -- not only covering American actions, but also summarizing the events that appear to have occurred within the Soviet world which may account for the particular.virulence and brutality of the Soviet dictator's reaction to the U-2 incident.

Thile the President must be commended for the dignity and composure with which he met the bluster and arrogance of Mr. Khrushchev, it is not the part of American patriotism to pretend that all is well. It is no service to the future security of our country to ignore the facts, to pretend that nothing very serious has happened.

There are matters of great urgency. There must be immediate preparation and planning for what could be even a greater crisis on Berlin. There must be immediate steps to restore confidence and mutual trust among the NATO allies. The lines of communication with the Sovict Government must not be broken by further mistakes.

In short, we must have a program not to repair the damage at the Summit, but to restore the whole edifice of American power and leadership.
