WAVERLY PLANS HOME-TOWN SALUTE FOR SENATOR AND MRS. HUMPHREY

Friends and neighbors of Senator and Mrs. Hubert Humphrey will give the couple a rousing home-town salute Sunday at a "Wright County Humphrey Day" celebration in Waverly Hall.

Wright County DFL chairman Russell A. Johnson has urged residents of adjoining counties to join in the program for the Humphreys, who maintain a permanent home at Lake Waverly.

"Humphrey Day" will start with a ham and baked beans dinner served from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the hall.

Musical entertainment will be provided by Arthur Dorma and his orchestra from Annandale, and Cliff Juetten on the electric organ.

The main program of entertainment and speeches -- including a short talk by Senator Humphrey -- will begin at 2 p.m. Coffee and cookies will be served after the program.

Daniel Graham of Waverly is general chairman of the celebration. Tickets for \$1 a person may be purchased from him at the Citizens State Bank of Waverly or from DFL committee members in (Wright, Hennepin, McLeod, Meeker, Stearns and Sherburne counties)
