MANTEREY HITS GOP "OBSTRUCTION AND REACTION"

SPRIMFIELD, MO., February 3 - Senator Hubert H. Humphrey (D., Minn.) said tenight that the "political dinoraurs of the extreme, radical right have mudged the Republican leadership deeper into the realm of reaction."

The Senate Majority Whip declared that in one year the Democratic Administration has given American new strength and confidence and moved the country ahead from the valley of recession and retreat to the high ground of prosperity and economic growth.

Hamphrey's remarks were prepared for delivery at the 39th Annual Jackson Day Banquet in Springfield.

"After one year of good political manners," Humphrey said, "the Republican leaders are again beginning to act like Republicans.

"How do Republicans act? -- They react.

"With no program of their own, they become professional 'aginners.' They become experts at carping criticism and

"The simily-four dollar question — or I should say the

"Boutched, bothered and bouldered by their political cromies of the extreme right — the Eirchites, the ec-called anti-communist crusciers and other political dimensure — the Republican leaders drift aimlessly and unhappily between your York, Bears, Animum and Southern California.

"They are still debating this question: Is it or is it not patriotic and American to enter the 20th Century?

"Under the pressure of the maios and the demography of the political dimensura of the right, Hepublican leaders shuffle and stumble deeper into the reals of reaction.

"We Democrate will not be moved backward. We are moving absed.

"In one year, we have seized the initiative on the intermetional fromt with the Allience for Progress, the Feace Corps and our successful afforts to save the United Nations from the paralleling grip of the Seviet Union.

"We have reorganized our fereign aid program, strengthened the HATO Alliance and have set before the world the challenge of the Peace Race.

"We will continue to move shead under responsible, progressive, Democratic leadership."
