Radicals of the Right

I am delighted to be with you this evening to discuss the radicals of the right-or to be more accurate -- of the way out right

In discussing the radical extremists of the right one is tempted to treat them as a great joke. For what they say and do is so fantastic and divorced from reality that it is difficult to believe that these people are not really just pulling our leg. After all, it is a little hard to take anyone serious who impugns the loyalty of President Eisenhower or the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. I can tell you that there are plenty of people who are in dead earnest in making such wild charges.

I wish you could see some of the mail that keeps pouring into my office from these self appointed patriots--these radical extremists. Their letters are no laughing matter. You get a little sick to your stomach reading too many of them at one time.

When you listen to these folks you wonder if be living in the same

world as are.

Where are all these Communists--in and out of government--to which they refer?

Is the United Nations really filled with Reds and Red sympathizers bent on destroying the United States?

Is social legislation such as minimum wage, social security, medical care for the aged, aid to dependent children, public housing and REA really leading us down the road to communism?

Can't our Supreme Court be trusted? Are the members of the Court--as appointed by our duly elected President and confirmed by a Senate chosen by the people of the 50 states--really not good, solid, loyal patriotic Americans?

Are people who work for equal rights for Negroes really lending themselves to the Soviet conspiracy?

Are trade union leaders somehow less than loyal Americans?

Is it grounds for suspicion when a person defends the First Amendment or the Fifth Amendment of the Constitution?

Was the Eisenhower Administration and is the present Administration really soft on communism?

Is the foreign aid program just a clever scheme being pushed by hidden Reds to bankrupt this nation?

Are the churches and temples infiltrated by members of the Red conspiracy?

Are those who believe in promoting world law and order really following the Communist party line?

Unfortunately, my friends, there are a good many people in this country who are spouting such nonsense. And there are a good many more who swallow it hook, line and sinker.

The radicals of the right are really suffering from a serious political illness. To date we haven't found thecure for it, but I am hopeful we will, so that these poor sick souls can be brought back to the world of political reality and make a constructive contribution to the body politic, rather then spending their time and money in efforts which can only help to tear down our democratic system which we charish in this country.

As you know, I have always been a great advocate of the fine work being done by the National Institutes of Health. Their work to conquer various diseases is to me one of the most exciting and heartening works of our government. I have been toying with the idea of proposing a new National Institute of Health for Political Illness. What a fascinating field it would have to explore! And think what a major breakthrough it would be when the cause of this political illness was discovered. I would not limit the Institute's study only to the radical right, but to the radical communist left as well because both extremes have so much in common.

There is just one obstacle to my proposal though. I doubt if the Institute would be able to get many radicals of the right or left to volunteer for such studies. And as a firm believer in civil liberties I would never agree to their being compelled to serve in such experiments.

As ludicrous as the radical right is, we cannot afford to treat

not sure that we can Nor do I think we can safely ignore them.

Adolph Hitler and his bully boys were ridiculous and no cause for alarm. But the Germans learned to their sorrow that the goose-stepping Nazis was more than a joke. Hitler and his cromies were politically too, but they won out over the politically same nonetheless.

I am not suggesting that the radical right in this country is going to

win out. I have no fear on this score. For I fervently believe that the vast

majority of Americans are devoted to our democratic way of life and cherish

our hard won liberties.

But we can not remove these extremists from our minds. First of all,
we must be alert to nail down their lies and smear tactics against loyal
patriotic. Americans. Their wild charges cannot go unanswered. We have a
moral obligation to stand up and answer these slanderers who would turn

American against American, and cast a spirit of fear and suspicion throughout
