

STATEMENT OF THE VICE PRESIDENT AT ROSE GARDEN CEREMONY HONORING THE INITIAL PARTICIPANTS IN THE YOUTH OPPORTUNITY CAMPAIGN

Mr. President, Secretary Connor, Secretary Wirtz, members of the Youth Opportunity Campaign Task Force, and distinguished guests:

Youth Opportunity Campaign to provide job opportunities for

out-of-work young people between the ages of 16 and 21. The
