(DRAFT OF MESSAGE FROM VICE PRESIDENT HUMPHREY TO YAMPA VALLEY RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE 25TH ANNUAL MEETING)

IT GIVES ME SPECIAL PLEASURE TO BE ABLE TO SAY HELLO TO YOU DECIME AND CONGRATULATE YOU ON THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF YOUR COOPER -ATIVE. I SAY, "SPECIAL PLEASURE," BECAUSE I GREW UP IN SOUTH DAKOTA AND MINNESOTA AND I SAW RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVES BEING FORMED THERE AND I CAME TO REALIZE RECEIVE QUICKLY HOW VITALLY IM-PORTANT THUS DECERAN TO THE RATION. I DON'T HAVE TO TELL DECOME DIME YOUR BOARD MEMBERS, MR. ARNOLD AND MRS. BRUNNER, AND SOME OF THE REST OF YOU, WHAT IT IS TO BE WITHOUT ELECTRICITY --WITHOUT ELECTRIC LIGHTS AND REFRIGERATION ON A FARM OR RANCH. YOU KNOW BECAUSE YOU HELPED GET YAMPA VALLEY ELECTRIC STARTED 25 YEARS AGO AND THAT'S WHAT THES PROGRAM IS ADDITATED TO THE LIGHT.

IT MAY EMBARRASS SOME OF YOU GOOD PEOPLE TO SAY THIS YOURSELVES, BUT I'VE SAID IT OFTEN ONE WAY OR THE OTHER OVER THE YEARS AND I'LL KEEP ON SAYING IT. THE RURAL ELECTRIFICATION PROGRAM IS THE BACKBONE FOR ECONOMIC PROGRESS IN OVER HALF THE NATION. IT'S THE LIFE BLOOD FOR MOST OF RURAL AMERICA. YOU PEOPLE ARE A PART OF IT YOU HELPED BUILD IT AND TURN IT FROM A DREAM INTO REALITY.

YOU KNOW, YOU CAN'T DO THESE THINGS UNLESS YOU HAVE A FREE NATION AND FREE PEOPLE. BUT YOU CAN'T DO THEM EITHER UNLESS THERE ARE PEOPLE WITH COURAGE AND IMAGINATION AND RESOURCEFULNESS. SO YOU ARE A PART OF THE GREATNESS OF THIS NATION. IT'S PEOPLE LIKE YOU HAVE HELD WHAT WE CALL THE AMERICAN DREAM AND HELPED TURN IT

THAT'S NOT JUST TALK. WHEN YOU FIRST STARTED OUT YOU HAD 175 MILES OF LINE TO SERVE 286 MEMBERS. NOW YOU'VE GOT NEARLY 16 HUNDRED MILES OF LINE TO SERVE 52 HUNDRED MEMBERS. MULTIPLY THOSE MEMBER CONSUMERS BY 4 TO COUNT IN ALL THE WIVES AND CHILDREN AND YOU COME OUT WITH ALMOST 22 THOUSAND PEOPLE THAT MAKE UP YOUR COOPERA-TIVE AND KEEP IT GOING.

THAT'S NOT ONLY A DREAM. THAT'S AN ACHIEVEMENT, ONE IN WHICH THE WHOLE COUNTRY CAN TAKE PRIDE. I INCOM THAT PRESIDENT JOHNSON AND I CERTAINLY DO.

AGAIN, LET ME EXTEND MY WARMEST CONGRATULATIONS TO YOU.

Message from Vice President Humphrey to Yampa Valley Rural Electric Cooperative 25th Annual Meeting

It gives me special pleasure to be able to say hello to you and to congratulate you on the 25th anniversary of your cooperative. I say "special pleasure" because I grew up in South Dakota and Minnesota and I saw rural Electric Cooperatives

being formed there, I came to realize quickly how vitally

important these cooperatives are to the nation....

I don't have to tell your board members, CArrold

and Mrs. Bronner, and the rest of you, what it is to be without

electricity -- without electric lights and refrigeration on a

farm or ranch. You know because you helped get Yampa Walley

Electric started 25 years ago. That's what our rural electric cooperatives have done -- bring America out of darkness into

light.

The Rural Electrification Program is the backbone for economic progress in over half the nation. It's the life

blood for most of rural America. You are a part of it. You helped build it and turn it from a dream into reality.

You can't do these things unless you have a free nation and free people. And you can't do them unless there are people with courage and imagination and resourcefulness. So you are a part of the greatness of this nation. You have helped turn the American dream into reality.

When you first started you had 175 miles of line to serve 286 members. Now you've got nearly 16 hundred miles of line to serve 5200 members. Multiply those member consumers by 4 to count the wives and children and you come out with almost 22 thousand people that make up your cooperative and keep it going. in which the whole country can take pride. President Johnson and I certainly do.

That's not only a dream. That's an achievement, one

to you.
