MEMO TO THE VICE PRESIDENT

FROM: NORMAN SHERMAN

RE: LADIES OF THE PRESS BACKGROUND

Attached is the script for "Ladies of the Press" which will surround the questioning. It is similar to your normal "Meet the Press" interviews.

You will be introduced first, followed by Gay Pauley, Catherine Mackin, and Bonnie Angelo. Your first question is hopefully a short question and answer and will likely be: "Mr. Vice President, will you still be Vice President in 1969" - or -"Will you be the Vice Presidential candidate in 1968?"

Other questions: "Is there a new Hubert Humphrey"?

"What comment do you have on the polls which show LBJ at a low point"?

(Possibly questions about mental retardation and Mrs. Humphrey's interest in it.)

(Possibly questions on the seating of Powell excluding any references to his own behavior; i.e., did the House act precipitously.)
