"IF WE WORK UPON MARBLE, IT WILL PERISH; IF ON BRASS TIME WILL EFFACE IT; IF WE REAR TEMPLES, THEY WILL CRUMBLE INTO DUST; BUT IF WE WORK UPON IMMORTAL MINDS, AND IMBUE THEM WITH PRINCIPLES, WITH THE JUST FEAR OF GOD AND LOVE OF OUR FELLOW MEN, WE ENGRAVE ON THOSE TABLETS SOMETHING THAT WILL BRIGHTEN TO ALL
