The consensus has been that you would not want prepared remarks for this dedication. Here, however, are a few background facts.

The Postmaster is Albert L. Gutzke, appointed in February, 1962.

The new building is more than twice the size of the old one, and cost \$23,540.

Net receipts last year were \$11,117.

The first Waverly post office was established in 1863. By 1867, its net annual receipts were \$1.36 and that year the Postmaster, Ammon D. Kingsley, was paid \$3.00 for his services.
