MR. MAYOR, MR. LEBARON, MY FRIENDS ON THE ATHLETIC TEAM, AND MOST IMPORTANTLY, MY YOUNG FRIENDS WHO HAVE COME FROM ALL OVER WASHINGTON TO BE HERE THIS MORNING, WELCOME.

TODAY WE WITNESS THE OPENING SESSION FOR THE SUMMER YOUTH SPORTS AND RECREATION PROGRAM TEAM. ED LeBARON HAS FILLED YOU IN ON WHAT THE YOUTH SPORTS AND RECREATION PROGRAM WILL BE DOING OVER THE NEXT FEW MONTHS, AND WHERE THIS TEAM NOW BEFORE YOU WILL BE TRAVELLING I WILL NOT REPEAT HIS REMARKS. BUT I WILL SAY THAT I VIEW THE SESSION THIS MORNING NOT ONLY AS THE KICKOFF TO THE YOUTH SPORTS AND RECREATION PROGRAM. ALSO VIEW TAS SYMBOLIC OF WHAT IS HAPPENING TO MAKE LIFE BETTER FOR YOUTH THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE COUNTRY THIS SUMMER.

OUR SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAM IN WASHINGTON, D. C. AND NATIONALLY IS FAR BETTER THIS YEAR THAN EVER BEFORE. DURING THE PERIOD FROM SUMMER 1964 TO SUMMER 1967 WE INCREASED THE NATIONWIDE EMPLOYMENT OF 16-21 YEAR OLD YOUTHS BY 2 MILLION WHILE AT THE SAME TIME REDUCING THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FROM 14.7% to 12.1%. EARLY INDICATIONS FOR SUMMER 1968 ARE THAT WE ARE DOING EVEN BETTER THIS YEAR.

FOR EXAMPLE, HERE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA THE NATIONAL ALLIANCE OF BUSINESSMEN HAS PROVIDED OVER 4,000 JOB ORDERS FOR DISADVANTAGED YOUTH. THAT COMPARES WITH ABOUT 300 SUCH JOBS LAST YEAR.

NATIONALLY, FEDERAL AGENCIES THIS SUMMER ARE HIRING 70,000 DISADVANTAGED YOUTH COMPARED TO 43,000 LAST YEAR AND A SUBSTANTIAL PART OF THAT INCREASE IS IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.

WHILE FAR TOO MANY SCHOOLS ARE STILL CLOSED DURING THE SUMMER MONTHS, OUR INFORMATION INDICATES THAT APPROXIMATELY 20% MORE SCHOOL FACILITIES WILL BE OPEN THIS YEAR THAN IN SUMMER, 1967.

AND YOU ARE SEEING EVIDENCE HERE TODAY OF NEW INNOVATIONS IN RECREATION PROGRAMS -- PROGRAMS DESIGNED TO BROADEN THE HORIZONS OF NEEDY YOUNG PEOPLE. BUT DESPITE THE FACT THAT OUR SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMS THIS YEAR ARE BETTER PLANNED, BETTER ORGANIZED, AND ARE REACHING MORE DISADVANTAGED YOUTH, WE ARE NOT SATISFIED.

MUCH NEEDS TO BE DONE. IF WE ARE TO TELL IT LIKE IT IS WE CANNOT IGNORE THAT THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FOR NON-WHITE TEENAGERS IS OVER 20%; THAT MANY OF OUR SCHOOLS ARE INADEQUATE; THAT LARGE NUMBERS OF OUR YOUTH WHO LIVE IN INNER CITY AREAS DO NOT RECEIVE PROPER MEDICAL ATTENTION OR LIVE IN DECENT HOUSING. YES, MUCH NEEDS TO BE DONE, AND THE PARTICIPATION AND SUPPORT OF YOUNG PEOPLE IS NEEDED IF PROGRAMS ARE TO SUCCEED, IT WILL REQUIRE THE INVOLVEMENT OF THOSE OF YOU HERE TODAY -- FROM THE WASHINGTON COLISEUM. FROM THE KENILWORTH COMMUNITY CENTER. AND FROM THE BENNING-STODDARD CENTERS -- FROM ALL SECTIONS OF THIS CITY. LET US CREATE AN ALLIANCE OF YOUTH THROUGHOUT THIS LAND TO CONSTRUCTIVELY BUILD THIS COUNTRY. THERE IS MUCH WORK TO BE DONE, AND THE TIME TO BEGIN IS NOW.
