NOTES ON MEETING OF VICE PRESIDENT HUMPHREY WITH THE CONFERENCE OF PRESIDENTS OF MAJOR AMERICAN JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS CONFERENCE OF PRESIDENTS OF MAJOR AMERICAN JEWISH ORGANIZATIONS

OCTOBER 30, 1968 New York City

The Vice President met for 50 minutes this afternoon with about 125 members of the Conference, which is made up of 21 national Jewish bodies -- religious and secular -- whose members represent the majority of the Jewish community of the United States.

After the meeting, during which the Vice President answered 10 questions, Rabbi Herschel Schacter, Chairman of the Conference, said those present "were heartened by Mr. Humphrey's understanding of the problems that are of deep concern to the American Jewish community." He was asked if the Conference endorsed the Vice President. He said the Conference "never endorses candidates." He said the Conference "was satisfied with the Vice President's candid answers to the questions." Mr Nixon made a similar appearance before the Conference on October 21.

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Following are notes from the question and answer session:

The Vice President was asked about the delay in the sale of Phantom jets to Israel. The Vice President answered that he favors prompt sale of the jets. Our country is going to see to it that Israel's defense needs are met, he said. "I promise that there will be no delay after January 20."

He called the Middle East a very dangerous area. He said it would take delicate negotiations balanced with firmness to bring about stability and peace. He said, The people of Israel and its government are justly concerned. He reiterated his six point program for a settlement in the Middle East. He said, There are neither new positions nor campaign promises. I didn't get any new religion. I've fought for these positions for a quarter of a century. I am neither a new nor a fair weather friend.

The Vice President pointed out that in 1956 while he was a delegate to the United Nations he 'denounced our policy of intervention in the Suez crisis. My opponent took to television to announce that Suez was our finenst hour."

He philosophized about what America should lock for in its relationships with other countries. He said he would look for "a willingness to fight for one's own independence...an interest in human welfare -- education, housing and health...an attitude toward individuals in the nation-state -- the right to speak, to write, to think." "These are the ideals we should look for, and Israel represents a great deal of this," he said. 'We can't afford to have this kind of light snuffed out. We need these kind of candles to light the darkness."

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The Vice President was then asked how he would respond to a Soviet threat to the security of Israel. "Aggression will not be permitted and will be resisted," he said.

He was asked about a settlement that might be forced by the major powers on the Middle East. The Vice President answered, I would hope that we might use the good offices of the United Nations to effect a settlement. But basically peace in the Middle East must be worked out by neighbors. I am not in favor of an imposed settlement."

He added that he was hopeful that the United States and the Soviet Union "can come to some agreement to end the arms race -- both nuclear and conventional weapons."

He was asked about lines of communication to the White House. He answered that he hoped he would always be available, as in the past, to talk with both individuals and groups.

He was asked about anti-Semitism in other nations. He answered, "I have never thought the United States has taken a sufficiently strong position with the Soviet Union on this issue." He added, "This is one of the guidelines I will lay down to my Secretary of State. There will be a new Secretary of State." He said, "We have a right to a clear definition of human rights," from the Soviet Union.

He was asked about his service as Vice President. He answered, It has been a wonderful but very difficult period of my life.'

He was asked about summit meetings. He replied that he has proposed a series of summit meetings. "The dialogue can be helpful," he said. "It isn't always a matter of peace and war. It's a matter of the environment you help create." He emphasized the need for firmness in dealing with the Soviet Union. 'The Soviet Union pounds away at us year after year after year. That's what we have to do. Our weakness is that we give them a light little slap and then move on. "

He was asked about the role he would give voluntary organizations in solving urban problems. He received long applause when he answered, "I intend to have my Vice President, Mr. Muskie, be the coordinator of our domestic programs." He said he believed in broad citizen participation, especially in planning new programs. There will be no problem about participation of the people in my Administration, " he said. "The problem will be if you have enough time."

I intend to make my remarks brief today and leave some time for questions.

I do not intend to speak extensively on the Middle East today. In the last quarter of a century, I have made hundreds of speeches in behalf of our country's vital interest in preserving the independence and territorial integrity of Israel.

There are six basic steps which must be taken in the Middle East.

I. The existence of the State of Israel must be accepted by all of its neighbors;

 The boundaries of all these countries must be transformed into agreed and secure frontiers;

 The State of Israel must have free navigational rights in all international waters, including the Suez Canal and the Gulf of Aqaba;

4. The arms race must be ended;

5. The international community must assist in solving the human tragedy posed by the Arab refugees;

6. The resources of the Middle East must be used for human and economic development rather than war and destruction.

These are neither new positions nor campaign promises with me. I have stated and fought for these basic principles for a quarter of a century -- both publicy, and in the most private. executive sessions of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, and in the inner councils of the executive branch.

I am neither a new nor a fair weather friend. And here I will be outrightly partisan -- because I think something must be said forthrightly and now.

In 1956, on the floor of the Senate, I denounced the Eisenhower-Dulles intervention in Suez I opposed efforts to block UJA contributions at the time I fought the ban on travel to Israel which Mr. There's Administration imposed for four months.

As Vice President, you will recall, Mr. Nixon took to the television networks and announced that Suez was our nation's finest hour by striking a blow against our colonial allies, Britain and France, to show our independence, and to join hands with the "third world" nations. My Middle East views were recently published in an interview for the Jewish Chronicle of London which appeared last Friday. They were kind enough to note that my promise to supply Israel with phantom jets was announced well before the President instructed Secretary Rusk to enter into negotiations -indeed, before any other candidate took a position.

Al believe there will be no undue delay. I promise there will be none in January

Incidentally, and I quote from the <u>Chronicle</u>, "Mr. Nixon did not answer the "Jewish Chronicle's" questions directly but asked our correspondent to find the answers to them in his B'nai B'rith speech. <u>In the broader area of foreign affairs</u>, I have outlined the steps of what I call "A New Strategy for Peace." As you know, I have spelled out in detail my Vietnam position. I have talked about

strengthening NATO, the United Nations, and expanding our multi-

lateral commitments to help developing nations.

There are other issues of vital concern in this campaign. One is racism. You know where I stand.

Aid to education is another crucial issue -- a matter of deep concern to everyone in this room. I have been an advocate for decades. The Kennedy-Johnson-Humphrey Administration has a magnificent record in education.

The opposition party has fought federal aid to education every step of the way -- and Mr. Nixon personally killed legislation to provide classroom construction and increased teachers salaries by casting a tie-breaking vote in the Senate when he was Vice President.

Last week, he campaigned throughout California with the superintendent of public instruction, Max Rafferty -- a man he said he needed to help him move his programs forward in Washington--A man whom the John Birch Society, in a recent fund-raising invitation, claimed as their own. I also recall total silence when our good friend Tommy Kuchel was in the rugged primary battle with Rafferty.

Americans are deeply concerned over the question of civil order. We see attacks on our courts and on the law itself -supposedly in the cause of law and order. We have seen Mr. Nixon and his allies block the nomination of Abe Fortas.

I bought time on national television and gave the nation some straight talk on the "law and order" issue.

I proposed <u>specific</u> programs to combat crime, to strengthen police, to go after dope pushers.

Is there anyone in this room who does not know, through five thousand years of history, that justice is fundamental to a healthy society -- that attacks on our courts are a fundamental blow to liberty? The final issue is arms control and disarmament. You know that this has been one of my abiding interests. One of my proudest accomplishments was the nuclear test ban treaty. Now we have the non-proliferation treaty whose ratification Mr. Nixon decided to block in this session of Congress.

Finally, let me say that I expect to meet with this group next in the White House. And I expect to meet with you frequently. But on those occasions when I am unavailable, I intend to designate a member of my White House staff who will be available to you on a continuing basis -- a staff person to whom you can turn whenever you feel that matters of importance should be brought to my attention.

The next President will have to be mature and decisive in his exercise of judgment and leadership. He will have to command and merit respect. The crucial question before the American people in this election is: who can you <u>trust</u> to lead this country in the next four years? On that basis, I am ready for the electorate's decision on Tuesday.

I INTEND TO MAKE MY REWARKS BRIEF TODAY AND LEAVE SOME TIME FOR QUESTIONS.

I DO NOT INTEND TO SPEAR EXTENSIVELY ON THE MIDDLE EAST TODAY. IN THE LAST QUARTER OF A CENTURY, I HAVE MADE HUNDREDS OF SPEECHES IN BEHALF OF OUR COUNTRY'S VITAL INTEREST IN PRESERVING THE INDEPENDENCE AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF ISRAEL.

THERE ARE SIX BASIC STEPS WHICH MUST BE TAKEN IN THE MIDDLE EAST. WHILE IT MAY BE NEWSWORTHY WHEN MY REPUBLICAN OPPONENT MAKES AN UNCHARACTERISTICALLY UNAMBIGUOUS STATEMENT, SUCH AS ON THE PHANTOM JET ISSUE, MY 25-YEAR OLD COMMITMENT WILL HARDLY MAKE HEADLINES.

THE FUNDAMENTAL, IRREDUCIBLE POINTS ARE THESE:

L. ISRAEL'S EXISTENCE AND HER FRONTIERS MUST BE RECOGNIZED AND ACCEPTED BY HER ARAB NEIGHBORS.

2. SHE MUST HAVE FREE NAVIGATIONAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING SUEZ AND AQUABA.

3. VE MUST RECOGNIZE THE FLOW OF ARMS FROM RUSSIA TO THE ARAB STATES AND WE MUST GUARANTEE THAT ISRAEL WILL NEVER BE INSECURE IHROUGH ANY FAILURE ON THE PART OF THE U.S. THIS INCLUDES IMMEDIATE SALE OF THE PHANTOM JETS--A POSITION I STATED PUBLICLY IN THE FIRST WEEM OF AUGUST.

4. WHILE THIRD PARTY EFFORTS MAY FACILITATE AGREEMENT, THERE OBVIOUSLY CAN BE NO FINAL CONTINUES RESOLUTION OF HOSTILITIES IN THE AREA WITHOUT DIRECT (CONTINUES) NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE PARITES ACTUALLY INVOLVED.

I ALSO BELIEVE IN THE NECESSITY TO PRESS RUSSIA ON A GENERAL REDUCTION IN THE ARMS RACE AND IN THE NECESSITY FOR COOPERATIVE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS IN THE ENTIRE AREA.

THESE ARE NEITHER NEW POSITIONS NOR CAMPAIGN PROMISES WITH ME. I HAVE STATED AND FOUGHT FOR THESE BASIC PHINCIPLES FOR A QUARTER OF A CENTURY-BOTH PUBLICLY, AND IN THE MOST PRIVATE, EXECUTIVE SESSIONS OF THE SEMATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE, AND IN THE INNER COUNCILS OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH.

I CONSIDER ISRAEL'S SECURITY AS VITAL TO THE SECURITY OF THE UNITED STATES. I LOOK TO ISRAEL AS AN <u>OUTPOST OF DEMOCRACY</u> CONTRACT IN THE ENTIRE REGION.

I AM NEITHER A NEW NOR A FAIR WEATHER FRIEND.

I DO NOT USE THE TERM "FAIR WEATHER FRIEND" LIGHTLY. WE ALL REMEMBER THE LAST TIME MR. WIXON HELD PUBLIC OFFICE--WHEN HE SPOKE POLICY, MOT CAMPAIGN GRATORY.

IN 1956, ON THE FLOOR OF THE SENATE, I DENOUNCED THE EISENHOWER-DULLES INTERVENTION IN SUEZ. I OPPOSED EFFORTS TO BLOCK UJA CONTRIBUTIONS AT THE TIME. I FOUGHT THE BAN ON TRAVEL TO ISRAEL WHICH MR. NIXON'S ADMINISTRATION IMPOSED FOR 4 MONTHS.

AS VICE PRESIDENT, YOU WILL RECALL, MR. MIXON TOOK TO THE TELEVISION NETWORKS AND ANNOUNCD THAT SUEZ WAS OUR NATION'S FINEST HOUR BY STRIKING A BLOW AGAINST OUR COLONIAL ALLIES, BRITAIN AND FRANCE, TO SHOW OUR INDEPENDENCE, AND TO JOIN HANDS WITH THE "THIRD WORLD" NATIONS. I ASK YOU NOW, HOW MANY FRIENDS IN THE THIRD WORLD DID THAT PARTICULAR POLICY GAIN US?

MY MIDDLE EAST VIEWS WERE RECENTLY PUBLISHED IN AN INTERVIEW FOR THE JEWISH CHRONICLE CONTROL OF LONDON WHICH APPEARED LAST FRIDAY. THEY WERE KIND ENOUGH TO NOTE THAT MY PROMISE TO SUPPLY ISRAEL WITH PHANTOM JETS WAS ANNOUNCED WELL BEFORE THE PRESIDENT INSTRUCTED SECRETARY AUSK TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS--INDEED, BEFORE ANY OTHER CANDIDATE TOOK A POSITION.

THERE ARE THOSE WHO BELIEVE THAT WE ARE STILL DRAGGING OUR FEEL. I HOPE AND BELIEVE THERE WILL BE NO UNDUE DELAY. I PROMISE THERE WILL BE NONE IN JANUARY. IN THE BROADER AREA OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS, I HAVE OUTLINED THE STEPS OF WHAT I CALL "A NEW STRATEGY FOR PEACE." AS YOU KNOW, I HAVE TALKED ABOUT CALCULATED RISKS FOR PEACE, INCLUDING A BOMBING HALT, A CEASE-FIRE, DE-AMERICANIZATION OF THE WAR AND FREE ELECTIONS, IN THE EVENT THE PEACE TALKS HAVE NOT MOVED FORWARD BY JANUARY 20, 1969. I HAVE TALKED ABOUT STRENGTHENING MATO, THE UNITED NATIONS, AND EXPANDING OUR MULTI-LATERAL COMMITMENTS TO HELP DEVELOPING NATIONS.

THERE ARE OTHER ISSUES OF VITAL CONCERN IN THIS CAMPAIGN. ONE IS THE WAY IN WHICH MR. NIXON AND I HANDLE THE RACIST CHALLENGE OF MR. WALLACE'S CANDIDACT. MY AFPEAL RAS BEEN TO THE "NEW SOUTH" OF TERRY SANFORD, CHARLES WELTMER AND JULIAN BOND; MR. NIXON'S SOUTHERN STRATEGY INCLUDES SUCH CAMPAIGN ADVISORS AS THE CHAIRMAN OF HIS "KEY ISSUES" GROUP, SENATOR TOWER OF TEXAS, AND MY OLD OPPONENT,STROM THURMOND.

AID TO EDUCATION IS ANOTHER CRUCIAL ISSUE--A MATTER OF DEEP CONCERN TO EVERYONE IN THIS ROOM. I HAVE BEEN AN ADVOCATE FOR DECADES. THE KENNEDY-JOHNSON-HUMPHREY ADMINISTRATION HAS A MAGNIFICENT RECORD IN EDUCATION.

MR. WIXON'S PARTY HAS FOUGHT FEDERAL AID TO EDUCATION EVERY STEP OF THE WAY--AND MR. NIXON PERSONALLY KILLED LEGISLATION TO PROVIDE CLASSROOM CONSTRUCTION AND INCREASED TEACHERS SALARIES BY CASTING A TIE-BREAKING VOTE IN THE SENATE WHEN HE WAS VICE PRESIDENT.

AND LAST WEEK, HE CAMPAIGNED THROUGHOUT CALIFORNIA WITH THE SUPERINTENDANT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, MAX RAFFERTY-A MAN HE SAID HE NEEDED TO HELP HIM MOVE HIS PROGRAMS FORWARD IN WASHINGTON; - A MAN WHOM THE JOHN BIRCH SOCIETY, IN A RECENT FUND RAISING INVITATION, CLAIMED AS THEIR OWN. I ALSO RECALL TOTAL SILENCE WHEN OUR GOOD FRIEND TOMMY KUCHEL WAS IN THE RUGGED PRIMARY BETTLE WITH HAFFERTY.

AMERICANS ARE DEEPLY CONCERNED OVER THE QUESTION OF CIVIL ORDER. WE KNOW WHAT WALLACE MEANS BY "LAW AND ORDER".

AND WE HNOW WHAT MR. NIXOW HAS ON HIS MIND WHEN HE DOWNGRADES PROGRAMS TO GET AT THE ROOTS OF CRIME AND CONCENTRATES ON ATTACKING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE SUPREME COURT, AND BLOCKS THE NOMINATION OF ABE FORTAS.

WHAT THESE MEN HAVE ON THEIR MINDS IS GARNERING REACTIONARY VOTES.

I BOUGHT TIME ON NATIONAL TELEVISION AND GAVE THE NATION SOME "STRAIGHT TALK" ON THE LAW AND ORDER ISSUE.

I PROPOSED <u>SPECIFIC</u> PROGRAMS TO COMBAT CRIME, TO STRENGTHEN POLICE, TO GO AFTER DOPE PUSHERS.

IS THERE ANYONE IN THIS ROOM WHO DOES NOT KNOW, THROUGH FIVE THOUSAND YEARS OF HISTORY, THAT JUSTICE IS FUNDAMENTAL TO A HEALTHY SOCIETY--THAT ATTACKS ON OUR COURTS ARE A FUNDAMENTAL BLOW TO LIBERTY?

THE FINAL ISSUE IS ARMS CONTROL AND DISARMAMENT. YOU KNOW THAT THIS HAS BEEN ONE OF MY ABIDING INTERESTS. ONE OF MY PROUDEST ACCOMPLISHMENTS WAS THE NUCLEAR TEST BAN TREATY. NOW WE HAVE THE NON-PROLIFERATION TREATY WHOSE RATIFICATION MR. NIXON DECIDED TO BLOC IN THIS SESSION OF CONGRESS.

FINALLY, LET ME SAY THAT I EXPECT TO MEET WITH THIS GROUP NEXT IN THE WHITE HOUSE. AND I EXPECT TO MEET WITH YOU FREQUENTLY. BUT ON THOSE OCCASIONS WHEN I AM UNAVAILABLE, I INTEND TO DESIGNATE A MEMBER OF MY WHITE HOUSE STAFF WHO WILL BE AVAILABLE TO YOU ON A CONTINUING BASIS--A STAFF PERSON TO WHOM YOU CAN TURN WHENEVER YOU FEEL THAT MATTERS OF IMPORTANCE SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO MY ATTENTION.

THE NEXT PRESIDENT WILL HAVE TO BE MATURE AND DECISIVE IN HIS EXERCISE OF JUDGMENT AND LEADERSHIP. HE WILL HAVE TO COMMAND AND MERIT RESPECT. THE CHUCIAL QUESTION BEFORE THE AMERICAN PROPLE IN THIS ELECTION IS: WHO CAN YOU TRUST COMMAND TO LEAD THIS COUNTRY IN THE NEXT FOUR YEARS? ON THAT BASIS, I AM READY FOR THE ELECTORATE'S DECISION ON TUESDAY.

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
