GOP SOUGHT TO BUY RATHER THAN EARN TRUST OF AMERICAN PEOPLE, HUMPHREY SAYS

Youngstown, Ohio--Vice President Hubert H. Humphrey said today that the Republicans "have tried to buy what can only be earned-the trust of the American people."

The Nixon-Agnew Campaign will set a new all-time record of campaign spending, up sharply from earlier record levels.

"They have failed, because the American voters are not just so many clicks in the Republican computer. They are mothers and fathers, people with elderly parents they care for, people with children in school."

"Just ask yourself," Humphrey said, "what life would be like in Youngstown today if Jack Kennedy had not beaten Richard Nixon in 1960.

"Your mother and father would have no medicare, and a lot less social security. They might be waiting for charity or more help from you--and ashamed of it.

"Richard Nixon cast the tie-breaking vote against Federal aid to education in 1960, so I doubt if your youngsters would have the benefits of it today.

"There are 35,000 young Ohioans in college this fall--your kids--with Federal loans and scholarships. They probably wouldn't be there if the Republicans had had their way with aid to higher education."

"And what about your job? The Republicans produced three jobkilling recessions in the 1950's," Humphrey said.

Humphrey also emphasized the need to slow, not accelerate as Nixon proposes, the dangerous, costly strategic arms race.

REMARKS VICE PRESIDENT HUBERT H. HUMPHREY DOWNTOWN RALLY YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO NOVEMBER 2, 1968

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There are now just three days left -- three days until the American people go quietly into their voting booths ... to make one of the most momentous decisions in their lives.

And the central question is clear.

Whom can you trust with the Presidency?

Whom can you trust to build a stable and an honorable peace? Whom can you trust to keep Americans living together ... and working together.

Whom do you trust ... period?

Ed Muskie and I have gone to the people.

We have the dust of America on our shoes ... and the concerns of America in our hearts.

We have spoken out ... and we have listened.

We have trusted the people ... and I believe we have earned their trust.

Our Republican opponents think there is another way -confetti and computers ... balloons and millions of dollars worth of television advertising.

They have tried to buy what can only be earned ... the trust of the American people.

And they have failed.

... Because the American voters are not just so many clicks in the Republican computer ...

They are mothers and fathers -- people with elderly parents they care for ... with children in school.

They want to know that they are going to have a lasting peace in Vietnam ... before another class of youngsters reaches draft age. They want an end to the nuclear armaments race.

They want to be able to count on a growing income and a safe, decent neighborhood for their families. PAGE TWO

They want to be respected, not manipulated.

Mr. Nixon and the Republican Party do not offer that kind of leadership.

Democrats do.

I have told you where I stand on Vietnam. Nixon has not.

Now the President has taken a wise and courageous step to end that cruel war ... a step that all Americans who love peace support.

I want to go on and build the structure of a stable ... and honorable ... peace in Southeast Asia. I want to bring our troops home as soon as it is possible. I want to put the billions we have had to spend in Vietnam to work at home, building a better America.

And I want to put a stop to the suicidal nuclear armaments race.

You know where I stand on the control of nuclear weapons. I fought for a test ban treaty to keep nuclear poisons out of our children's milk ... and Richard Nixon called it a "cruel hoax" and "catastrophic nonsense."

Now Mr. Nixon is talking about a non-existent security gap... and calling for a fifty-billion dollar escalation in the nuclear arms race.

I say we don't need the weapons ... we are already the strongest nation on the earth ... and we can save that fifty billion dollars for schools and hospitals and better neighborhoods.

And here at home ... just ask yourself what life would be like in Youngstown today if Jack Kennedy had not beaten Richard Nixon in 1960.

Your mother and father would have no Medicare ... and a lot less Social Security. They might be waiting for charity ... or more help from you -- and ashamed of it.

There are 35 thousand young Ohioans in college this fall -your kids -- with federal loans and scholarships. They probably wouldn't be there if the Republicans had had their way with aid to higher education.

And what about your job? The Republicans produced three job-killing recessions in the 1950's.

You remember what it was like here in 1958 -- with one man out of twelve out of a job. Now it is less than one in thirty.

After 92 months of uninterrupted Democratic prosperity, the Republicans still haven't learned their lesson.

Mr. Nixon's economic advisers are calling for more unemployment as a way of keeping wages down and controlling prices.

Whose job will be the first to go, Mr. Republican ... whose overtime?

Make no mistake about it: If the Republicans get into the White House, you are going to have more unemployment. They have said so. They are actually committed, as a matter of Republican policy, to deliberately throwing men out of work.

It is no longer a question of whether there will be a recession if the Republicans get in. It's only a question of how long it will last and how deep it will cut.

I pledge this to every family in America: We will have full employment and economic growth in the Humphrey-Muskie Administration ... and you can count on it.

I also pledge this: The Humphrey-Muskie Administration will halt the rise in the cost of living -- and we'll reform the tax structure so no family pays more than its fair share.

But we need not -- and we will not -- sacrifice prosperity on the alter of outdated Republican economics.

I want to say a special word to the ladies in the audience -- not only as mothers and shoppers and homemakers -- but as individuals.

In 1963 I sponsored an amendment to the Constitution to assure equal rights for women. We must now push forward to achieve these objectives. PAGE FOUR

I helped pass legislation which prohibits discrimination in employment on the basis of sex.

When I am President, the Federal Government will be a model employer of women -- and this means from the White House on down.

For women who seek to resume their former careers or to prepare for new careers when their children are grown, we can -and we must -- help them in this effort.

I have proposed an adult opportunity act which will support continuing programs of adult education and special refresher courses.

The abilities, the skills, and the energies of the women of America have too long been wasted.

When I am President, this waste will be ended and a new day for American women will dawn.

I set out to show the American people that they are better than they sometimes think they are ... more fair and less prejudiced ... more thoughtful and less emotional ... more courageous and less fearful than some politicians think.

And I believe they have responded. For there is greatness in us. I'm proud that a team of Americans ... of all races ... swept up 107 medals at the Olympics in Mexico City ... I'm proud that we won all the Nobel prizes in science this year -- and the winners' names were Luis Alvarez ... Lars Onsager ... Robert Holley ... Marshall Nirenberg ... Har Khorana. The sound of America is in those names.

And now we can hope that we are on the way to peace in Vietnam. I say let's make the best of this opportunity.

I say let's make the best of our country.

I say ... let America now move on to achieve the greatness that can be ours.

It's up to you. The choice is yours.




