- 2 -HAVEN'T MADE A POINT OR A SINGLE FIRST DOWN -- WE HAVEN'T EVEN HAD POSSESSION OF THE BALL.

-- AND -- UNEMPLOYMENT WAS DOWN TO 3.5% -- THE LOWEST SINCE THE ROBERN WAR ECONOMIC SWELL.

WE DID HAVE A RAPIDLY EXPANDING ECONOMY WITH A GROWTH RATE THAT COULD BE MAINTAINED AND MODERATED SOMEWHAT BUT THAT REQUIRED KEEPING ANNUAL PRICE INCREASES TO BETWEEN 2 I/2 AND 3 I/2 PER CENT.

BUT THE JOHNSON ADMINISTRATION MADE VERY CLEAR THAT GOVERNMENT ALONE COULD NOT CONTROL INFLATION BY "FINE TUNING" VIA ITS MONETARY AND FISCAL TOOLS.

- 4 -BROAD POLICIES CAN BE IMPLEMENTED BUT THEY ARE NOT COMPLETELY EFFECTIVE WITHOUT THE COOPERATION OF THE PRIVATE SECTOR. WE ARE FACED WITH A SERIOUS ECONOMIC PROBLEM IN THIS NATION TODAY. BUT WHAT SPECIFIC STEPS HAVE BEEN TAKEN, VIA THE''GAME PLAN,'' EFFECTIVELY TO CONTROL THE WAGE-PRICE SPIRAL AND HIGH UNEMPLOYMENT AND TO STIMULATE A STAGNANT ECONOMY?

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THE ADMINISTRATION MAKES PROMISES OF DOING MUCH TO CURE THE ECONOMIC ILLS OF THE NATION.

THE PRESIDENT IN HIS FIRST NEWS CONFERENCE STATED FLATLY: 'WE CAN CONTROL INFLATION WITHOUT AN INCREASE IN UNEMPLOYMENT.''

THESE ARE FINE-SOUNDING DECLARATIONS, BUT THE POWERS AND PREROGATIVES OF THE PRESIDENT DO NOT PERMIT THE INCUMBENT TO MAKE THINGS SO BY WISHING THEM SO.



AND SO THE ECONOMY STUBBORNLY WORSENS INSTEAD OF

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WE ARE TOLD THAT THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL 1972 IS AN EXPANSIONARY ONE -- A FULL-EMPLOYMENT BUDGET. I THINK THIS IS ANOTHER WAY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION TO COVER UP THE FACT THAT IT FULLY EXPECTS TO HAVE A DEFICIT IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD OF \$15 BILLION OR MORE.

FULL EMPLOYMENT BUDGET IS MERELY THIS DEFICIT

BUT WHAT IS A FULL-EMPLOYMENT BUDGET? I REMEMBER MR. MCCRACKEN STATING "FULL EMPLOYMENT" IS UNEMPLOYMENT OF AROUND 3.8% OF THE CIVILIAN WORK FORCE. WE ARE NOW TOLD THAT "FULL EMPLOYMENT" IS AROUND THE 4.5% "ZONE."

THIS MEANS THE ADMINISTRATION HAS BEEN UNABLE EVEN TO APPROACH THEIR PROMISED LOW UNEMPLOYMENT FIGURE. IT'S MUCH EASIER TO CHANGE THE DEFINITION for achieve if ! OF "FULL EMPLOYMENT." THIS IS FINE UNLESS YOU HAPPEN TO BE ONE OF THE MILLION UNEMPLOYED REPRESENTED BY THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN 3.8% AND 4.7 OR 4.8%.

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THIS IS THE QUESTION I THINK WE MUST ASK OURSELVES WHEN CONSIDERING THIS "SELF-FULFILLING DREAM OF ORDERLY EXPANSION": "IS IT REALLY A REPUBLICAN CONVERSION TO KEYNESIAN ECONOMICS OR IS IT A FACADE TO COVER UP INEVITABLE DEFICITS RESULTING FROM REPUBLICAN MISMANAGEMENT OF THE ECONOMY? - 8 - 001010

I TRUST IT IS A TRUE CONVERSION. I TRUST IT DOES NOT REPRESENT ANOTHER ATTEMPT TO STIMULATE GROWTH AND CREATE PROSPERITY BY FILLING AMERICANS WITH FALSE HOPES OF SWIFT ECONOMIC RECOVERY --ANOTHER ATTEMPT TO GET THE CONSUMER BUYING AND THE BUSINESSMAN INVESTING BY TRYING TO MAKE GOOD TIMES APPEAR BY WISHING HARD ENOUGH FOR THEM.

I <u>PERSONALLY</u> BELIEVE IN THE POWER OF POSITIVE THINKING. <u>I</u> BELIEVE THAT FAITH <u>CAN</u> MOVE MOUNTAINS. BUT, SAD TO SAY, <u>MY FRIENDS</u>, THE ECONOMY HAS PROVEN TO BE, AT BEST, AN AGNOSTIC.

HOWEVER, WE WERE PLEASED THEN BY THESE PROMISES AS WE WERE LATER ASTOUNDED BY THE CARTE BLANCHE FOR PRICE AND WAGE (GOUGES) CONTAINED IN THIS STATEMENT OF THEPRESIDENT ON JANUARY 27, 1969:

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"I DO NOT GO ALONG WITH THE SUGGESTION THAT INFLATION EFFECTIVELY BE CONTROLLED BY EXHORTING LABOR AND MANAGEMENT AND INDUSTRY TO FOLLOW CERTAIN GUIDELINES . . THE LEADERS OF LABOR AND THE LEADERS OF MANAGEMENT, MUCH AS THEY MIGHT PERSONALLY WANT TO DO WHAT IS IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE NATION, HAVE TO BE GUIDED BY THE INTERESTS OF THE ORGANIZATION THAT THEY REPRESENT."

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I SUGGEST TO YOU LABOR LEADERS OF THE NATION THAT THIS IS AN <u>INVITATION</u> TO HIGHLY INFLATIONARY WAGE SETTLEMENTS AND PRICE INCREASES. THE PRESIDENT HAS SAID TO LABOR AND MANAGEMENT: "DO IT TO THEM, BEFORE THEY DO IT TO YOU." APPARENTLY BOTH SIDES OF THE TABLE STARTED DOING JUST THAT.

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I NEEDN'T GO INTO RECENT WAGE SETTLEMENTS. WE ARE ALL AWARE OF THEM. HOWEVER IN PRICES I HAVE SOME INTERESTING RELATIONSHIPS TO POINT OUT. FOR EXAMPLE:

IN THE 1966-68 "JAWBONING" PERIOD, THE PRICE OF GASOLINE FELL .6% IN 1969 ALONE, DURING THE BEGINNING OF THIS POLICY OF "NO POLICY," THE PRICE ROSE 3.5%.

FINISHED STEEL PRICES ROSE 1.6% DURING 66-68; THEY ROSE 6.8% IN 69.

COPPER WIRE AND CABLE PRICES ROSE 1.7% DURING 66-68; THEY ROSE -- AND GET THIS -- 22.2% DURING 1969.

THESE INCREASES SHOW THAT FOR THESE ITEMS, THE EXTRA INCREASE, OVERALL, REPRESENTS BETWEEN 1/3 AND 2/3 OF THE TOTAL ACCELERATION.

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THE INCREASE IN STEEL IS PARTICULARLY SIGNIFICANT WHEN YOU RECALL HOW MUCH OF OUR TOTAL INDUSTRIAL OUTPUT USES THAT METAL. THE INCREASE IN STEEL IS PAID FOR BY YOU AND ME WHEN WE BUY A CAR OR AN APPLICANCE, OR BUILD A

YOU AND I ARE CONTINUING TO PAY THE PRICE OF THIS PROLONGED IRRESPONSIBILITY -- WHOSE RESPONSIBILITY BELONGS FIRST AND FOREMOST TO THE PRESENT NATIONAL ADMINISTRATION.

NOW WHAT HAVE BEEN THE RESULTS OF THE "GAME PLAN" OFFERED BY THE PRESENT ADMINISTRATION? WELL RETURNING FROM THE ECONOMICS CLASS TO THE GRIDIRON: THE SCORE IS ---- GAME PLAN ZERO --BUT -- UNEMPLOYMENT -- APPROXIMATELY 6% -- HIGHEST SINCE 1961, THE LAST REPUBLICAN RECESSION.

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GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT ---- SHOWING AN ACTUAL DECREASE IN REAL GROWTH FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE 1958, THE <u>NEXT TO THE LAST</u> REPUBLICAN RECESSION. THIS IS PARTICULARLY IRONIC SINCE THE GNP IS STALLING DESPITE THAT FANCY NEW GOP-GNP CLOCK THE ADMINISTRATION STARTED RUNNING---APPARENTLY IN THE WRONG ECONOMIC TIME ZONE!

PRICES ---- NON-FOOD AND SERVICES -- UP TO AN ANNUAL RATE OF 7.2%.



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THESE THEN ARE THE RESULTS OF THE LEADERSHIP VACUUM IN ECONOMIC POLICY:

-- ACCELERATED AND UNDULY PROLONGED INFLATION:

-- SOARING INTEREST RATES AND FINANCIAL DISRUPTIONS:

-- STAGNATION OF PRODUCTION AND JOBS, THE COST OF WHICH CONTINUES TO GROW;

-- POLICIES THAT HAVE REMAINED LONG ON HOPES AND SHORT ON ACHIEVEMENTS."

THESE DESCRIPTIONS OF OUR GAME PLAN LOSSES ARE BY GARDNER ACKLEY, WALTER HELLER AND ARTHUR OKUN, ALL FORMER CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL OF ECONOMIC ADVISERS.



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IT ISN'T OFTEN YOU GET THREE ECONOMISTS OF THAT STATURE TO AGREE ON THE WIND DIRECTION IN A GALE, SO I FIND THEIR EVALUATIONS AS CONVINCING AS I FIND THEM DISTURBING.

THESE STATISTICS, COMPARISONS, AND EVALUATIONS OF THE WAGE-PRICE SPIRAL, UNEMPLOYMENT, RETURN ON INVESTMENT, CORPORATE PROFITS, AND CAPACITY UTILIZATION -- ARE DISTURBING TO US ALL. WHETHER WE ARE A WIDOW LIVING ON SOCIAL SECURITY OR A CORPORATE MANAGER, WE ARE AFFECTED BY THIS I. INCREASING SLACK IN THE GREAT AMERICAN ECONOMY.

THIS SLACK, OR GNP GAP, AS IT IS CALLED, COS AMERICANS \$60 BILLION IN 1970. SHOULD THIS RATE OF ECONOMIC NON-GROWTH OR STAGNATION CONTINUE, IT WILL HAVE COST US APPROXIMATELY \$120 BILLION BY THE END OF CALENDAR 1971.

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THINK OF IT! \$120 BILLION.

-- OVER \$50 BILLION IN REAL INCOME THAT AMERICANS WILL NEVER SPEND;

-- OVER \$18 BILLION IN AFTER-TAX CORPORATE PROFITS;

-- OVER \$5 BILLION THAT OUR CRISIS-RIDDEN STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS WILL NEVER COLLECT IN TAXES;

AND -- OVER \$28 BILLION THAT CANNOT BE USED TO FINANCE THE FEDERAL PROGRAMS THIS NATION MUST CONTINU AND EXPAND IF WE ARE TO PROVIDE THAT LIFE OF QUALITY TO ALL AMERICANS.

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LOOKING AT THE \$15 BILLION LOST THIS YEAR IN FEDERAL REVENUES, BECAUSE OF THE ADMINISTRATION'S FAILURE TO PROVIDE THE NECESSARY LEADERSHIP, IS SURELY THEIR JUST REWARD FOR THAT FAILURE IT WOULD JUST ABOUT COVER THE PROJECTED BUDGET DEFICIT FOR FISCAL 1971.

BUT MORE TO THE POINT, THIS LOSS CAN NEVER BE RECOVERED TO FINANCE EDUCATION, HEALTH RESEARCH AND SERVICES, TOTAL EQUAL OPPORTUNITY, DEVELOPMENT OF OUR OWN NATIONAL POTENTIAL AND THE POTENTIALS OF EMERGING NATIONS THROUGHOUT THE COMMUNITY OF MAN. WE MUST HELP THEM ALSO, IF FOR NO OTHER REASON THAN OUR OWN BEST ECONOMIC AND FOREIGN POLICY INTERESTS APPARENTLY, AS A RESULT OF ALL-BUT UNIVERSAL URGING, THE ADMINISTRATION FINALLY DECIDED THAT HAND-WRINGING AND EXPRESSIONS OF PERSONAL PIQUE AND SORROW ARE NOT ENOUGH TO ESTABLISH ECONOMIC STABILITY OR INDUCE RESTRAINT ON THE PART OF LABOR AND MANAGEMENT. AS I MENTIONED EARLIER, THE BUDGET PROJECTS DEFICIT SPENDING OF AROUND \$15 BILLION.

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ON MONETARY POLICY, THE FED. SHOULD BECOME SOMEWHAT MORE LIBERAL THAN IT IS AT PRESENT. IT WILL BE NECESSARY FOR THE MONEY SUPPLY TO INCREASE AT LEAST BY 5% TO SUPPORT AN ECONOMY THAT MUST RECOVER ABOUT 6% IN CURRENT PRICES. **@O**ME EXPERTS FEEL THAT THE BEST MEDIAN GROWTH RATE TO FOCUS ON IS 8%. TO REACH ''FULL-EMPLOYMENT'' BY MID-1972 WOULD REQUIRE AN INCREASE ON THE ORDER OF 10%.

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SUCH INCREASES -- 8% OR 10% -- HOWEVER, ARE NOT ABOUT TO BE FORTHCOMING, PARTICULARLY IN THE ABSENCE OF (SEVERE) RESTRAINT BUSINESS AND LABOR IN PRICES AND WAGES. CHAIRMAN ARTHUR BURNS OF THE FED. HAS RULED OUT SUCH INCREASES AS HIGHLY INFLATIONARY.

CLEARLY, MONETARY POLICY CANNOT BALANCE THE ECONOMY ALONE. FISCAL POLICY AS WE HAVE SEEN DEMONSTRATED THESE PAST TWO YEARS, CANNOT DO IT ALONE. EVEN THE TWO IN PERFECT BALANCE CANNOT RETURN PRICE INCREASE AND UNEMPLOYMENT RATES TO ACCEPTABLE LEVELS.

WHAT THEN IS LEFT TO PLACE IN THIS SEEMINGLY UNSOLVABLE EQUATION? WHAT IS THE MISSING FACTOR OR SPARK?

WHAT DOES THE ECONOMY AND WE WHO MAKE UP THAT ECONOMY NEED?

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WE NEED LEADERSHIP!

WE NEED THE LEADERSHIP OF A COURAGEOUS INCOMES POLICY, EXERCISING RESTRAINT OVER WAGES AND PRICES!

THE PRESIDENT MUST PLACE TEMPORARY POLITICAL PAIN IN SECOND PLACE -- FOR A WHILE; IF NOT FOREVER. FIRST PLACE -- FIRST PRIORITY MUST BE GIVEN TO THE SOUND AND STEADY GROWTH OF THE ECONOMY -- WITH "FULL EMPLOYMENT" AND WAGE AND PRICE STABILITY BASED ON PRODUCTIVITY AND TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS.

WAGE AND PRICE GUIDELINES ARE AN ABSOLUTE MUST FOR OUR RETURN TO THIS TYPE OF ECONOMIC STABILITY. THE PRESIDENT MUST REALIZE THIS AND IMPLEMENT SUCH A POLICY SOON.

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THE LIST OF THOSE URGING THIS TYPE OF LEADERSHIP READS LIKE THE CANON OF SAINTS IN THE CATHOLIC MASS. EVERY RESPONSIBLE NATIONAL BODY POLITIC HAS URGED THIS COURSE OF ACTION.

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THE CONGRESS HAS PASSED LEGISLATION GIVING THE PRESIDENT STATUTORY "FREEZING POWER" OVER WAGES AND PRICES AND CONTROLS OVER ALLOCATION OF CREDIT. HE SIGNED THE BILLS WHILE SAYING HE WOULD NEVER USE THE POWERS THEY CONFERRED.

YET LEADERS IN THE CONGRESS -- BOTH DEMOCRATIC AND REPUBLICAN -- HAVE URGED AN INCOMES POLICY CONTINUALLY.

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I URGE THE PRESIDENT TO LOOK AGAIN AT WHAT THE "GAME PLAN" HAS DONE TO THE AMERICAN ECONOMY. I URGE HIM TO EXAMINE THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CONGRESS. THE C.E.D. AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE FEDERAL RESERVE BOARD. I FIRMLY BELIEVE THAT the type of ESTABLISHMENT OF COUSE AND PRICE BOARD RECOMMENDED BY THE C.E.D. AND REINFORCED BY MR. BURNS WOULD BE THE MOST EFFECTIVE MEANS TO SIGNAL THE NATION AND THE WORLD THAT THE POLICY OF "NO POLICY" HAS COME TO AN END.

IT'S TIME FOR THE PRESIDENT TO LAY IT ON THE LINE WITH THE AMERICAN PEOPLE, TO TELL US WHAT RESPONSIBILITY HE IS WILLING TO ACCEPT AND WHAT STEPS HE IS WILLING TO TAKE.

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WHAT WE NOW HAVE IS A CRISIS OF CONFIDENCE. IF PRESIDENT NIXON CONTINUES SAYING EVERYTHING IS WORKING OUT ACCORDING TO PLAN, THIS CRISIS --THIS LACK OF CONFIDENCE IN NIXON ECONOMIC POLICIES --WILL CONTINUE.

YOU ARE LEADERS IN **SUCCESS AND WAR** COMMUNITIES! YOUR VOICES ARE LISTENED TO AND HEEDED. YOU TOUCH MANY BUSINESSES AND MANY PEOPLE. YOU REALIZE WHAT INFLATION IS DOING TO THE NATION.

LET LABOR BEGIN ITS OWN INCOMES POLICY --LET LABOR SHOW THE WAY HERE TO THE ADMINISTRATION.

YOU BE THE LEADERS. DEMONSTRATE YOUR LONG-TERM ECONOMIC AND DEMOCRATIC WISDOM. THE COUNTRY NEEDS THIS WISDOM. THE PEOPLE NEED THIS LEADERSHIP. IF THOSE WHO ARE SUPPOSED TO PROVIDE IT ABDICATE THEIR RESPONSIBILITIES, IT IS UP TO YOU TO REALIZE WHAT IS IN YOUR OWN

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AND THE COUNTRY'S BEST INTERESTS.

WE SHOULD, EACH ONE OF US, BURN IN OUR ZEAL TO SEE THIS GREAT PRODUCTIVE BLENDING OF THE MINDS, HEARTS AND MUSCLE OF AMERICANS CONTINUE ITS GROWTH. THE ECONOMY'S GROWTH IS OUR GROWTH. ITS GROWTH IS A MEASURE OF OUR ABILITY, AS A NATION AND AS INDIVIDUALS, TO ACCOMPLISH WHAT WE KNOW WE CAN AND MUST ACCOMPLISH. ITS FAILURE TO GROW IS OUR FAILURE.

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ITS FAILURE TO GROW LEAVES UNDONE THOSE DEEDS THAT ENHANCE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR ALL AMERICANS. AND THOSE DEPRIVED ARE THOSE WHO CAN LEAST AFFORD FURTHER DEPRIVATION OF MIND, BODY AND SOUL -- DEPRIVATION THAT LONG AGO BECAME INSTEAD A DEPREDATION.

WHEN TIMES ARE LEAN THOSE VOICELESS ONES --THE POOR, THE DISADVANTAGED, THE UNEDUCATED, THE HANDICAPPED -- ARE THE FIRST TO SUFFER -- THE FIRST TO HAVE THEIR PART OF THE AMERICAN DREAM DISAPPEAR IN A FLASH -- ONLY A BITTER AFTER-TASTE LINGERING ON. A "PRESENT HOPE -- THEIR FUTURE SORROW." (T. S. ELIOT -- MURDER IN THE CATHEDRAL.)

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
