∠ IF WE WERE NOW TO DRAW UP A SCORE CARD, MATCHING PERFORMANCE AGAINST THESE DEFINED GOALS, THE FINAL SCORE WOULD NOT PLACE ANY SINGLE NATION OR GROUP OF NATIONS, OR IN FACT OUR GENERATION OF CIVILIZATION IN THE WINNER'S BOX, WITHOUT POINTING THE FINGER AT ANY ONE, THERE IS NOT AN ABUNDANCE OF EVIDENCE TO SHOW THAT WE ARE EVEN CLOSE TO ATTAINING THE NOBLE AIMS WHICH WE HAD HOPES OF ACHIEVING WHEN THE UNITED NATIONS WAS FOUNDED ON THE ASHES OF WORLD WAR II.

WHILE THE SCORE HAS NOT BEEN PHENOMENALLY HIGH, THERE HAS BEEN ENOUGH ACTION TO KEEP THE GAME MOVING FORWARD, PLAYERS HAVE STUCK WITH IT AND SOME OF THE MORE POWERFUL ONES HAVE TAKEN A RENEWED INTEREST IN IMPROVING THE PERFORMANCE

AS WE LOOK AT THE UNITED NATIONS IN ITS 25TH YEAR, WE CAN, THEREFORE, NOT GO OVERBOARD IN REJOICING BUT ON THE OTHER HAND, WE SHOULD NOT GO INTO MOURNING THE UNITED NATIONS IS ALIVE AND WELL; WHAT IT NEEDS MOST OF ALL IS AN ADDED SPIRIT AND STRUCTURAL FLEXIBILITY CAPABLE OF COPING WITH TODAY'S DEMANDS OF INTERNATIONAL SOCIETY, THE SHOT OF ADRENALIN MUST COME FROM THE MEMBERS THEMSELVES, ESPECIALLY THE UNITED STATES WHO IS A FOUNDING FATHER AND WHOSE INFLUENCE COULD BE THE NECESSARY CATALYST FOR STRENGTHENING THE ENTIRE NETWORK OF INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS / FROM THE VANTAGE OF HINDSIGHT, IT IS MOST

PLAUSIBLE TO CONCLUDE THAT ONE REASON FOR THE

RELATIVELY LACK LUSTER PERFORMANCE WAS THE SCALE

OF THE GOALS WE SET FOR OURSELVES, WHICH WERE BLOWN UP BEYOND HUMAN PROPORTION. IF THESE GOALS SERVE, ON THE OTHER HAND, AS A GUIDELINE FOR INTERNATIONAL BEHAVIOR THE RECORD IS NOT NEARLY AS GRIM, NOR IS THE POSSIBILITY OF MAKING REAL ADVANCES NEARLY AS REMOTE.

I THINK MEMBERS ARE MORE CONSCIOUS OF REDUCING THEIR GOALS TO A MANAGEABLE SIZE THAN THEY WERE AT THE OUTSET, MOSTLY BECAUSE OF A PROCESS OF THERE IS HOPEFULLY A GREATER APPRECIATION OF NATIONAL DIFFERENCES AND A CONSCIOUS ATTEMPT TO MOVE FORWARD SLOWLY, EVEN IF IT IS IN STOPS AND STARTS! / JOHN STEINBECK NOTED MAN'S ENTIRE EXISTENCE IS SPENT IN MOVING TWO STEPS FORWARD AND ONE STEP BACKWARD.

It is perhaps the basic design of our lives. What MAKES THE WHOLE PROCESS WORTHWHILE IS THE EXCITEMENT AND GRATIFICATION OF ACTUALLY MAKING PROGRESS AND RETAINING OUR FORWARD MOMENTUM.

WE SHOULD NOT DEMAND FROM THE UNITED NATIONS

ANY MORE THAN WE ASK FOR OUR OWN LIVES -- MOVEMENT

IN STOPS AND STARTS BUT, NEVERTHELESS, REAL

PROGRESS, ONE AREA WHERE WE CAN REALLY PUSH AHEAD

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AND ON THE OTHER MUST BE THE NECESSARY LEADERSHIP TO PROVIDE THE KIND OF INSPIRATION NECESSARY FOR WIDER, MORE RESOLUTE COOPERATION AND COMMITMENT. 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UNDOUBTEDLY ONE OF THE MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS THE 25TH ANNIVERSARY SESSION WAS THE ADOPTION ON OCTOBER 24 OF THE INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY FOR THE SECOND UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT DECADE, BEGINNING JANUARY I OF THIS YEAR, THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED A COMPREHENSIVE STRATEGY DOCUMENT WHICH LAUNCHED THE SECOND DEVELOPMENT DECADE, (+T +NCLUDES TRADE FLYANCIAL RESOURCE TRANSF SHIPPING SPECIAL MEASURES IN FAVOR OF THE LEAST DEVELOPED AMONG THE DEVELOPING ALSO FOR LANDLUCKED COUNTRIES. THE AND TECHNOLOGY, HUMAN DEVELOPMENT EXPANSION AND BIVE

OF PRODUCTION.

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ONE OF THE KEY PROVISIONS OF THE DOCUMENT WAS THE RECOMMENDATION THAT EACH ECONOMICALLY ADVANCED COUNTRY SHOULD ENDEAVOR TO PROVIDE TO DEVELOPING COUNTRIES, BY 1972 AND AT THE LATEST BY 1975, FINANCIAL R NET AMOUNT EQUIVALENT TO I PER CENT OF ITS GROSS NATIONAL PRODUCT. THE UNITED STATES WHO WAS ONCE THE LEADER OF ECONOMIC ASSISTANCE HAS NOT YET ENDORSED THIS TARGET STRONGLY URGE THE IF WE DO NOT HAVE GREATER ANOTHER EQUALLY IMPORTANT POINT ADOPTED IN STRATEGY STATEMENT WAS THAT GOVERNMENTS "WILL

ARREST THE DETERIORATION OF THE HUMAN ENVIRONMENT

AND TO TAKE MEASURES TOWARDS ITS IMPROVEMENT, AND TO PROMOTE ACTIVITIES THAT WILL HELP TO MAINTAIN THE ECOLOGICAL BALANCE ON WHICH HUMAN SURVIVAL DEPENDS, PARTICULAR EMPHASIS HAS BEEN PLACED, AS IT SHOULD BE, ON THE LINK BETWEEN ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL AND ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT, AND FACT THAT WHILE MANY TECHNOLOGICAL QUE REMAIN TO BE SOLVED, PROBLEMS OF THE HUMAN ENVIRONMENT ARE INCREASINGLY OF A SOCIO-ECONOMIC NATURE

A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF WORK HAS ALREADY BEEN

DONE IN THIS AREA DURING THE FIRST DEVELOPMENT

DECADE. POLLUTION OF THE SEAS WAS ONE OF THE

EARLIEST ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS CONSIDERED TO

WARRANT INTERNATIONAL ACTION.

AN INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION WAS SIGNED IN 1954 IN THAT REGARD.

THE CONVENTION ON THE HIGH SEAS CALLS FOR FUTURE REGULATION TO PREVENT POLLUTION; THE CONVENTION ON FISHING AND CONSERVATION OF THE LIVING RESOURCES OF THE HIGH SEAS OF 1966 STRESSES THE NEED FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION TO PREVENT THE DANGER OF OVER-FISHING; AND THE CONVENTION ON THE CONTINENTAL SHELF OF 1964 WHICH STIPULATES THAT THE "EXPLORATION OF THE CONTINENTAL SHELF AND NATURAL RESOURCES MUST NOT RESULT IN ANY UNJUSTIFIABLE INTERFERENCE WITH . . . THE CONSERVATION OF THE LIVING RESOURCES OF THE SEA."

QUESTIONS OF ATOMIC ENERGY AND SOURCES OF ENERGY.

AS WELL AS A NUMBER OF CONFERENCES ON FAMILY PLANNING

THESE EFFORTS CREATED THE GENERAL ATMOSPHERE
FOR MORE PRECISE WORK WHICH BE DONE IN
THE NEXT DECADE. I BELIEVE THAT WE MUST ACT ON
THE GLOBAL ASPECTS OF POLLUTION FOR TWO BASIC
REASONS, EACH OF WHICH CONCERNS THE FUTURE OF
MEN ON EARTH.

WHEN THE SOOT FROM ENGLISH FACTORIES TURNS THE

SNOW OF SWEDEN BLACK -- THAT IS A FORM OF AGGRESSION,
WHEN AMERICAN WASTES FOUL THE OCEAN SO THAT

EXPLORER THOR HEYERDAHL SEES GARBAGE AND OIL SLICKS
IN MID-OCEAN -- AND THE OCEAN IS INTERNATIONAL

PROPERTY -- THEN THAT IS A FORM OF AGGRESSION, AND
INTERNATIONAL AGGRESSION REQUIRES INTERNATIONAL

ACTION.

1 MY SECOND REASON IS THAT WE MUST ALWAYS BE ON THE LOOKOUT FOR TURNING POTENTIAL ADVERSITY INTO REALISTIC PROGRESS . THE WAYS OF POLITICAL PROGRESS ARE SOMETIMES STRANGE, 4 THE TRAGEDY OF THE DEPRESSION IN THE UNITED STATES GAVE BIRTH TO SOME LONG-TERM LEGISLATION (SUCH AS SOCIAL SECURITY) THAT HAS BENEFITTED AMERICANS LONG AFTER THE DEPRESSION PASSED, THE TRAGEDY OF THE WAR IN VIETNAM TURNED AMERICAN THOUGHT TOWARD --AMONG OTHER THINGS -- THE MASSIVE AMOUNTS OF MONEY THAT IS DIRECTED TOWARD MILITARY SPENDING . L TODAY, AS A RESULT OF THAT SORT OF AWAKENING, MILITARY SPENDING IS BEING REDUCED.

IN A SIMILAR FASHION, I BELIEVE THAT THE

POTENTIAL ECOLOGICAL CRISIS MAY PROVIDE MANKIND

WITH AN OPPORTUNITY TO GET OFF THE DIME AND MAKE

ONE SMALL STEP TOWARD A SYSTEM OF WORLD LAW

HERE, SPECIFICALLY, IS MY PROPOSAL.

IN 1971, A SPECIAL WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE OUGHT TO BE CONVENED TO CONSIDER A PLAN TO CREATE, THROUGH THE UNITED NATIONS, A BODY OF INTERNATIONAL LAW DIRECTED TOWARD PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT; AND A U. N. COMMISSION ON POLLUTION CONTROL TO ENFORCE THE LAW THIS COMMISSION'S FIRST FUNCTION --ONCE ESTABLISHED BY THE U. N. -- WOULD BE TO CREATE INTERNATIONAL POLLUTION CODES AND QUALITY STANDARDS THAT WILL INSURE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE IN 1971 OUGHT TO PROPOSE GUIDELINES FOR SUCH STANDARDS.

THEN, IN 1972, THE AMERICAN DELEGATION TO THE STOCKHOLM U. N. ENVIRONMENTAL CONFERENCE OUGHT TO PROPOSE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SUCH A U. N. COMMISSION (HOPEFULLY BY 1973, A PLAN FOR A COMMISSION, WITH A MODEL SET OF STANDARDS COULD BE PRESENTED TO THE U. N. GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR APPROVAL.

LTHE UNITED STATES SHOULD THEN EXERCISE ALL OF ITS POLITICAL MUSCLE IN THE UNITED NATIONS TO ESTABLISH THIS COMMISSION FURTHERMORE, WE SHOULD ACTIVELY AIM OUR WORK IN THE U. N. TO SEE TO IT THAT THIS NEW COMMISSION BE GIVEN A RARE AND CRUCIAL COMMODITY IN THE REALM OF U. N. ORGANIZATIONS: POWER THE NEW U. N. POLLUTION CONTROL COMMISSION WILL BE EFFECTIVE ONLY IF ITS CHARTER HAS TEETH IN IT TO ENFORCE ITS CODES. 534

AS A FIRST STEP, THE COMMISSION SOUGHT TO BE GIVEN POWER TO IMPOSE FORMS OF COMMERCIAL SANCTIONS ON NATIONS WHO VIOLATE THE POLLUTION CODES.

THIS MAY PROVE DIFFICULT, BUT THIS IS AN UNPRECEDENTED UNDERTAKING. THE ISSUE AT STAKE IS NOT IN THE FAMILIAR REALM OF POWER POLITICS -- WHICH OFTEN BRINGS OUT THE WORST IN EACH OF THE MEMBER NATIONS. THE ISSUE WE ARE TALKING ABOUT INVOLVES THE VERY SURVIVAL OF THE SPECIES OF MAN.

IT IS AN ATTEMPT TO LET THE SPECIES OF MAN LIVE

IN DIGNITY ON THIS BEAUTIFUL PLANET CREATED BY HIS

MAKER.

THIS ISSUE TRANSCENDS REGIONAL OR IDEOLOGICAL RIVALRIES, LPOLLUTED OCEANS WILL WASH THE SHORES OF NATIONS BOTH COMMUNIST AND CAPITALIST -- OLD AND NEW -- RICH AND POOR.

THE SYSTEMATIC DATA COLLECTION AND MONITORING OF POLLUTION LEVELS; EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION AMONG COUNTRIES: SETTING OF INTERNATIONAL STANDARDS AND LIMITS FOR CHEMICAL, PHYSICAL AND BIOLOGICAL FACTORS: PROMOTION OF SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH TO DEVELOP ENVIRONMENT-SAVING ALTERNATIVES, SUCH AS PLANT DERIVATIVES AND BIOLOGICAL METHODS TO REPLACE PERSISTANT TOXIC CHEMICALS FOR CONTROLLING PESTS AND THE FORMULATION OF NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICIES AND PLANS, TO ENSURE AND ACHIEVEMENT OF SUCH GOALS AS CONTROL OF URBAN SPRAWL. RATIONAL MANAGEMENT OF RESOURCES, AND EXPANDED LOW-COST HOUSING.

LI PLACE MY FAITH IN THE UNITED NATIONS TO

CARRY OUT THESE PROGRAMS KNOWING FULL WELL THAT IT

HAS BEEN FAR LESS THAN A TOTAL SUCCESS IN RECENT

YEARS. BUT I SAY IT KNOWING THAT UNLESS WE HUMAN

BEINGS BEGIN TO MAKE THE UNITED NATIONS FUNCTION

BETTER THAN IT NOW DOES, WE MAY PERISH NOT FROM
