



THIS IS TRUE ON TWO ACCOUNTS. FIRST, IT IS MAKE BELIEVE BECAUSE WE ARE TOLD THAT THE ECONOMY'S SERIOUS ILLS ARE BEING TREATED WITH "GAME PLANS." SECOND ON THE LIST OF MAKE-BELIEVE IS THE STORY TOLD US BY THE WHITE HOUSE, WHILE THEY ARE MANUFACTURING THIS "INFLATION CURE," THAT THINGS ARE BETTER AND BETTER AS THEY REALLY BECOME WORSE AND WORSE. WHEN I READ THE ADMINISTRATION'S ECONOMIC REPORTS I WONDER.

I REALLY WONDER IF SOMEONE DIDN'T SLIP "ALICE IN WONDERLAND" OR THROUGH THE LOOKING GLASS" TO THE PRINTER. OR MAYBE THEY NOW HAVE LEWIS CARROLL ON THE COUNCIL OF ECONOMIC ADVISERS. I WOULDN'T BE SURPRISED.

YES, IN TRYING TO COOL THE FIRES OF INFLATION, THE ADMINISTRATION HAS DOUBLED THE RATE OF UNEMPLOYMENT IN THIS COUNTRY. I SAY THAT THEY HAVE DONE THIS AND DONE IT DELIBERATELY. THIS RECESSION IS NOT PART OF ANY IMPERSONAL BUSINESS CYCLE BROUGHT ABOUT BY AN UNLUCKY TURN OF THE ECONOMIC WHEEL. THIS RECESSION WAS PLANNED. IT WAS INHERENT IN THE REPUBLICAN PLAN TO BATTLE INFLATION.



BUT WE DON'T INTEND TO WAIT UNTIL THE NEXT PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION TO MOUNT THE DRIVE FOR FULL EMPLOYMENT IN AMERICA, WE INTEND TO DO WHAT WE CAN RIGHT HERE AND NOW. IF THE PRESIDENT VETOES OUR LEGISLATION, WE WILL TRY TO OVERRIDE HIS VETO. LIF HE SIGNS OUR LEGISLATION, WELL AND GOOD. IF WE MAKE THE GOOD FIGHT AND LOSE, LET THE AMERICAN PEOPLE KNOW WHO IS RESPONSIBLE FOR WHAT, BUT WE DO NOT INTEND TO STAND BY AND WATCH OUR ECONOMY COOLED DOWN TO MAKE THIS AN ECONOMIC ICE AGE FREEZING THE HOMES AND HOPES OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE.

We Will act now - and we enterd to warm fing up - economically + Politically.

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001377 ACT NOW . WE NTEND TO WARM HINGS ON TRADE, THE PRESIDENT CONTINUES TO PLAY BOTH SIDES AGAINST THE MIDDLE. MILLS HAS BEEN G BUT, HE WAS ABLE TO DO SOMETHING THAT THE ADMINISTRATION FAILED UTTERLY EVEN TO APPROACH L HE NEGOTIATED WITH THE JAPANESE, L IF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OR THE WHITE HOUSE CAN'T CUT THE MUSTARD WITH THE JAPANESE, THEY MIGHT BE WELL ADVISED TO ASK MR. 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THEIR RECENT OFFER, WHILE VAGUE AND IMPRECISE, TO LIMIT OVERALL TEXTILE EXPORTS IS A FIRST RESPONSE TO YOUR CAMPAIGN.

4 THIS IS, AT BEST ONLY A BEGINNING.
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THIS ACKNOWLEDGES THE EXISTENCE OF A PROBLEM, BUT THERE MUST BE A LIMITATION NOT ONLY ON THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF EXPORTS PERMITTED, BUT A DELINEATION OF TEXTILE AND APPAREL CATEGORIES AND THEIR INDIVIDUAL LIMITATIONS (IN ADDITION, THERE ARE OTHER COUNTRIES BESIDES JAPAN INVOLVED IN WHAT MUST BE A MULTILATERAL AGREEMENT, TAIWAN, HONG KONG AND KOREA MUST BE INCLUDED IN ANY MEANINGFUL VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT.

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AND IT WILL BE MORE DIFFICULT TO FIND ACCOMMODATION WITH THESE COUNTRIES BECAUSE THEY ARE ECONOMICALLY LESS STRONG AND DIVERSIFIED THAN JAPAN. LIMITATIONS FOR THEM WILL BE COMPARATIVELY MORE PAINFUL THAN FOR JAPAN. LIMITATIONS WILL BE VERY DIFFICULT TO MONITOR AND VERIFY. DURING 1956-60 ON THE COTTON AGREEMENT SHIPMENTS EXCEEDED QUOTAS DESPITE GOVERNMENT EFFORTS TO ADHERE TO THESE LIMITATIONS, WE CAN AND MUST DO BETTER I URGE THE PRESIDENT TO TAKE STEPS TO SEE THAT IF MEANINGFUL NEGOTIATIONS ARE TO HAVE ANY CHANCE OF SUCCESS HE MAKE THIS CLEAR TO THE NEGOTIATORS.
