ATLANTA, GEORIGA NOVEMBER 15, 1971 I UNDERSTAND THAT THE THEME OF THIS CONFERENCE IS "New DIMENSIONS IN MARKETING." AND IT'S PLAIN TO SEE WHAT THE DIMENSIONS OF YOUR MARKETING PROBLEMS ARE.

On the one hand, you have a simple sales Job You must

SELL ENOUGH OF YOUR PRODUCT TO MEET THE GROWING EXPENSE OF

PROVIDING ELECTRIC SERVICE

ON THE OTHER, YOU ARE FACED WITH A NUMBER OF URGENT

FIRST, RURAL AREAS WHICH NEED MORE POWER BUT FIND THAT THE

MONEY WHICH CONGRESS APPROPRIATED FOR THIS PURPOSE HAS BEEN

IMPOUNDED BY THE ADMINISTRATION,

THE ADMINISTRATION IS SITTING ON SOME \$200 MILLION OF THE

\$545 MILLION IN REA FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY CONGRESS THIS YEAR,

THAT MONEY IN TURN IS PART OF THE MORE THAN \$12 BILLION -- FULLY

APPROPRIATED BY CONGRESS FOR A RANGE OF URGENT PROBLEMS -- BEING

WITHHELD BY THE ADMINISTRATION THIS YEAR

I HAVE INTRODUCED LEGISLATION TO REQUIRE THE EXECUTIVE

BRANCH THE FUTURE TO NOTIFY CONGRESS WHEN IT INTENDS TO TAKE

SUCH ACTION, SUPPLEMENTED WITH DETAILED EXPLANATIONS AS TO

WHY, AND FOR HOW LONG.

THAT MAY HELP US IN THE FUTURE. BUT FOR THE MOMENT, THE

action from the executive Branch

Second, THE FAILURE BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO COME UP WITH

THE FINANCIAL FORMULAS TO PROVIDE YOUR SYSTEMS WITH THE GENERATION

CAPACITY THEY NEED

AND THIRD, THE CONTINUING EXODUS FROM RURAL AMERICA OF

MILLIONS OF PEOPLE -- PARTICULARLY THE YOUNG -- INTO THE ALREADY

OVER-CONGESTED BIG CITIES

SEVENTY-FIVE PERCENT OF OUR PEOPLE ARE NOW CROWDED ONTO

LESS THAN TWO PERCENT OF THE LAND.

THE FUTURE OF RURAL ELECTRICS LIES IN REVERSING, OR AT LEAST ARRESTING, THIS RURAL TO URBAN MIGRATION.

RURAL ELECTRICS MUST REMAIN FINANCIALLY STRONG SO THEY CAN
REPAY THE MILLIONS OF DOLLARS STILL OWED TO THE GOVERNMENT, AND
SO THEY CAN MEET THEIR OVERHEAD.

The only way they have of adding to revenue is through
Additional sales of electricity. And the only way to expand your
SALES IS IN A HEALTHY, VITAL, GROWING RURAL AMERICA.

RURAL ELECTRIC CO-OPS HAVE BEEN INNOVATORS AND LEADERS IN THE UTILITY INDUSTRY IN PROTECTING AND ENHANCING THE PUBLIC INTEREST.

THEREFORE, YOU WILL BE FAITHFUL TO THE

GREAT TRADITIONS OF YOUR PROGRAM IF YOU INSIST THAT RURAL ELECTRIC

MARKETING MUST FOCUS ON OVERALL IMPROVEMENT OF RURAL COMMUNITIES

-- HELPING PEOPLE TO OBTAIN GOOD JOBS, DECENT HOUSING, AND THE OTHER ESSENTIALS TO UPGRADE THE QUALITY OF RURAL LIFE.

YOUR GOAL -- THE NATION'S GOAL -- MUST BE THE BUILDING OF BETTER AMERICAN COUNTRYSIDE, WHERE PEOPLE WILL WANT TO LOW THIS WILL REQUIRE THE INVESTMENT OF TIME HARD WORK AND BUT I'VE SEEN WHAT THE RURAL ELECTRICS ARE DOING TOWARD RURAL RENEWAL IN SOUTH DAKOTA AND ELSEWHERE, AND I KNOW IT CAN BE DONE. AND THIS KIND OF APPROACH WILL RETURN BIG DIVIDENDS, BOTH IN TERMS OF SOCIAL ACCOMPLISHMENT AND ECONOMIC PROGRESS. RURAL ELECTRIC COOPERATIVES CAN HAVE ENORMOUS IMPORT IN THIS DRIVE TO REVITALIZE RURAL AREAS. You ALREADY HAVE AN IMPRESSIVE RECORD OF ACHIEVEMENT.

RURAL ELECTRICATION ITSEEF HAS BEEN AN HISTORIC RURAL

DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM, AND DECAUSE OF ITS SUCCESS. THE FEDERAL

GOVERNMENT HAS PROVIDED THE FAVORABLE LOAN TERMS NEEDED TO

ACCOMPLISH THIS SOCIAL OBJECTIVE.

THE REA PROGRAM HAS CREATED THOUSANDS OF NEW JOBS (IT HAS DIRECTLY IMPROVED THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR MILLIONS OF AMERICANS.

MANY OF YOU ALSO HAVE BEEN DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN INDUSTRIAL

DEVELOPMENT OTHERS HAVE HELPED THEIR COMMUNITIES OBTAIN

ESSENTIAL FACILITIES SUCH AS WATER AND SEWER SYSTEMS. YOU HAVE

DONE MUCH. BUT WE ALL NEED TO DO MORE.

I believe we have made an important start with the Senate $\label{eq:Subcommittee} \text{Subcommittee on Rural Development, of which I am chairman.}$

We're NEW WE HAVEN'T DEVELOPED ANYTHING LIKE THE TRACK

RECORD YOU HAVE BUT WE'RE MOVING.

We have taken our Subcommitted out of the confines of Washington into the heart of rural America, holding field hearings in Georgia, Alabama, Iowa, South Dakota, Oklahoma and Nebraska.

IN THE COURSE OF THESE HEARINGS, WE HAVE SOUGHT ADVICE FROM HUNDREDS OF THE REAL EXPERTS ON RURAL PROBLEMS -- THE PEOPLE WHO LIVE AND WORK IN THE COUNTRYSIDE.

These HEARINGS HAVE LED TO A RURAL DEVELOPMENT CREDIT - Banking

ACT, WHICH I BELIEVE CAN INFUSE NEW ECONOMIC LIFE AND ENERGY
INTO RURAL AMERICA.

THIS BILL, WHICH I INTRODUCED WITH SENATOR HERMAN

TALMADGE, THE CHAIRMAN OF OUR FULL AGRICULTURE COMMITTEE,

PICKS UP WHERE THE HOMESTEAD ACT OF A HUNDRED YEARS AGO LEFT

OFF, IN TRYING TO PROMOTE AN INTELLIGENT, RATIONAL GROWTH

POLICY FOR THIS NATION.

IT WOULD PROVIDE WHAT WE CALL HARD AND SOFT CREDIT FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE RURAL BORROWERS, WITHIN A SYSTEM NEARLY IDENTICAL TO THE SUCCESSFUL FARM CREDIT SYSTEM.

HAVE SIMILAR PROGRAMS FOR UNDERDEVELOPED NATIONS OVERSEAS, THROUGH SUCH HIGHLY-SUCCESSFUL INSTITUTIONS AS THE WORLD BANK Isn't it about time we did as much for our own communities? I SAY IF WE CAN HELP BUILD A BETTER RIO DO JANEIRO OR LIMA, PERU, WE CAN HELP THOUSANDS OF SMALL TOWNS, AND VILLAGES AND COMMUNITIES RIGHT HERE AT HOME. SIMPLY STATED, THE RURAL DEVELOPMENT CREDIT ACT WOULD DO FOR NON-FARM CREDIT WHAT FARM CREDIT DOES FOR THE FARMERS IS DESIGNED TO DISPERSE NEW INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT, COMMUNITIES OF UNDER 35,000 POPULATION, I THINK IT WILL PROVIDE MANY OF

BUT IT CAN ACCOMPLISH MUCH MORE:

IT CAN PROVIDE FINANCING FOR NEW INDUSTRY -- AND THAT MEANS NEW PAYROLLS AND NEW JOBS; FINANCING FOR BETTER SCHOOLS; FOR MEDICAL CENTERS AND HOSPITALS FOR PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS: FOR IMPROVED TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS: FOR DAY-CARE FACILITIES; FOR CULTURAL CENTERS; SANITATION SYSTEMS; AND FOR DESPERATELY NEEDED HOUSING. AND MUCH MORE ! INDUSTRIAL PARKS; COMMUNITY COLLEGES; STREETS AND HIGHWAYS; POLICE AND FIRE STATIONS; LIBRARIES -- THE WHOLE GAMUT OF FACILITIES AND SERVICES WHICH ARE NEEDED TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE IN RURAL AMERICA. THERE ARE TWO MAIN FEATURES OF THE BILL.

FIRST, IT REORGANIZES THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE TO INSURE A MAJOR EMPHASIS ON FINANCING FARM CREDIT AND NON-FARM RURAL DEVELOPMENT REQUIREMENTS, AND SECOND, IT EXPANDS RURAL CREDIT BY MAKING IT AVAILABLE TO PRIVATE AND PUBLIC BORROWERS UNABLE TO GET CREDIT FROM COMMERCIAL SOURCES FOR RURAL DEVELOPMENT PURPOSES, MOST OF THE CAPITAL FOR THIS SYSTEM WOULD COME FROM PRIVATE SOURCES, SO THERE WOULD BE A COMBINATION OF CAPITAL INVESTMENTS BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, PLUS A LARGE MEASURE OF

PRIVATE CAPITAL BUILT ON THE PRINCIPLE OF THE FARM CREDIT SYSTEM.

In other words, instead of dollars flowing out of rural

AMERICA TO THE MAJOR MONEY MARKETS WE PROPOSE TO REVERSE THIS

FLOW OF MONEY SO THAT RURAL PEOPLE CAN USE IT TO HELP THEMSELVES

WHEN BOB PARTRIDGE, THE GENERAL MANAGER OF YOUR NATIONAL

ASSOCIATION, TESTIFIED ON THE BILL IN SEPTEMBER, HE CALLED IT

ONE OF THE BOLDEST, MOST IMAGINATIVE PIECES OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT

LEGISLATION EVER PROPOSED.

HE ADDED, "WE SUPPORT ITS CONCEPT AND BELIEVE THAT IT CAN

PROVIDE THE BROAD, MASSIVE ASSISTANCE NECESSARY TO PROVIDE

SUCCESSFUL, COMPREHENSIVE RURAL DEVELOPMENT."

Your NATIONAL ASSOCIATION SUBMITTED A NUMBER OF

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR STRENGTHENING THIS LEGISLATION WHICH OUR

COMMITTEE HAS ACCEPTED.

WHETHER OR NOT THE GOALS OF THE RURAL DEVELOPMENT CREDIT

BILL ARE ACHIEVED DEPENDS LARGELY ON THE INVOLVEMENT OF LOCAL

PEOPLE LIKE YOURSELVES. RURAL DEVELOPMENT DEPENDS ON LOCAL

LEADERSHIP. (We Med Jun Med - Write Call)

IF WE COULD RENEW RURAL AMERICA SIMPLY THROUGH THE FEDERAL

GOVERNMENT I'D BE AGAINST IT. THE PEOPLE WHO HAVE THE MOST

AT STAKE -- RURAL AMERICANS -- HAVE TO PLAY A BIG PART IN MAKING

ANY GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE SUCCEED

AN APPROPRIATE ANALOGY, IT SEEMS TO ME, IS THE RURAL ELECTRIFICATION ACT OF 1935, THERE WAS NO ASSURANCE THAT IT WOULD WORK BUT THE KEY TO ITS SUCCESS WAS THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE RURAL ELECTRIC CO-OPS, WHICH YOU MANAGE.

THAT'S WHY I URGE YOU AND YOUR RURAL ELECTRIC SYSTEMS TO ASSUME A LEADING ROLE IN TURNING AROUND THE ECONOMY AND THE MIGRATION PATTERNS IN THE COUNTRYSIDE, ALREADY, THE LONG KNIVES ARE OUT IN AN ATTEMPT BY THE ADMINISTRATION AND OTHERS WHO HAVE LITTLE CONCERN FOR THE PEOPLE YOU SERVE, TO KILL THE HUMPHREY-TALMADGE RURAL DEVELOPMENT BILL UNFORTUNATELY, THERE ARE NO LOBBIES IN WASHINGTON FOR NON-FARM RURAL PEOPLE, SO THE GOING IS GOING TO BE TOUGH WE You have as much at stake here as any organization I can Your expertise and enthusiasm, made to be felt in WASHINGTON, ARE CRITICAL TO THE SUCCESS OF THIS CRUSADE AND

TO THE SUCCESS OF THIS VITAL BILL.

WE MUST STOP THIS SENSELESS GEOGRAPHIC, ECONOMIC,

DEMOGRAPHIC IMBALANCE BETWEEN RURAL AND URBAN AREAS -- AN

IMBALANCE THAT ADDS UP TO ONE OF THE MOST SERIOUS PROBLEMS FACING

OUR NATION.

AND I'M GOING TO KEEP FIGHTING ON THIS ISSUE, NO MATTER

WHAT PRESSURES ARE BROUGHT TO BEAR TO KEEP RURAL PEOPLE FROM

HAVING THE FULL BENEFITS OF THIS WEALTHY SOCIETY.

I AM IN THIS BATTLE TO WIN WE CANNOT REST UNTIL ALL THE

CAUSES AND SYMPTOMS OF RURAL POVERTY AND UNDER-EMPLOYMENT ARE

ERADICATED

UNTIL THE NATION HAS IMPLEMENTED A STRONG AGRESSIVE RURAL

URBAN-BALANCE THAT PROVIDES FOR A BETTER GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES, OF JOBS, OF PEOPLE.

UNTIL THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR MILLIONS OF AMERICANS IN RURAL

AMERICA IS SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED.

BUT A HANDFUL OF U.S. SENATORS AREN'T GOING TO GET THE JOB

DONE WITHOUT THE LOUD SUPPORT OF PEOPLE LIKE YOU.

WHAT WE ARE TALKING ABOUT IS SIMPLY THIS: THE RIGHT OF ALL
