MAY 16 MARYLAND PRIMARY WITH A FULL SLATE OF DELEGATES.

I THINK MARYLAND VOTERS, IN PART BECAUSE OF THEIR PROXIMITY TO THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, KNOW MY RECORD AND MY QUALIFICATIONS AS WELL AS THE VOTERS OF ANY STATE. IN 1968 THEY GAVE ME THEIR VOTE. I WAS FORTUNATE ENOUGH TO CARRY THE BALTIMORE AREA WITH A RECORD VOTE FOR A DEMOCRATIC CANDIDATE.
