HUMPHREY SAYS KILLING OF POLICE, FIREMEN, PRISON GUARDS SHOULD BE FEDERAL CRIME

MIAMI, March 8-- Senator Hubert H. Humphrey today proposed that the killing of local and state police, firemen and prison guards be made a " Federal crime to help stem "the alarming increase in killings of these officers."

Speaking at the Crime Commission of Greater Miami's National Crime Forum, Humphrey said Federal jurisdiction in such crimes would mean "the immediate and total commitment of the vast resources of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the full commitment of the Federal judicial process.

"It would mean that no matter where these crimes might occur-from the smallest town to the largest city--the resources and personnel of the FBI would be pressed into the job of apprehending the criminal."

Humphrey said the number of policemen murdered in the line of duty had more than tripled in the last decade, rising from 37 in 1961 to 126 ten years later.

In the past ten years, more than 700 policemen and 44 firemen were killed by violent attacks, he said. And in 1970-71, 18 prison guards ware slain.

Humphrey said three policemen were killed in the line of duty in Florida in fiscal 1971--in Leon County, in Pahokee and in Miami. And in the South Atlantic region, the National Associat on of Chiefs of Police reports that 16 officers were killed and 275 injured in the same year.

Humphrey pointed out that the number of kidnapings showed a dramatic drop when that crime was added to the Federal list.

There were nearly 300 kidnapings ln 1931, he said. But when kidnaping was made a Federal crime, the number dropped to an annual average of just 28.

Humphrey also called for greater protection of the dependents of public safety officers and for compensation to the victims of crime.

The Victims of Crime act of 1972, of which Humphrey is a major cosponsor, would provide up to \$60,000 of no-cost life insurance to public officers, he said.

It also would compensate the victims of cirme and their dependents for injuries and salary losses incurred as a result of a crime.

"The battle against crime in America is long and unrelenting," Humphrey said. "The least we can do--and must do--is protect our public safety officers and help those who are the victims of crime.

"A time of genuine personal security is not visionary. We can have it. Meanwhile, the forgotten victims of crime must not be forgotten any longer.

REMARKS BY SENATOR HUBERT H. HUMPHREY

NATIONAL CRIME FORUM

MIAMI, FLORIDA March 8, 1972 WE ARE FIGHTING A WAR IN THIS COUNTRY--A WAR AS HARD AND AS DEADLY AS ANY WE HAVE EVER FOUGHT ON FOREIGN SHORES. WE ARE FIGHTING A WAR AGAINST CRIME.

WE ARE FIGHTING THIS WAR IN EVERY COMMUNITY IN THIS COUNTRY. OUR SOLDIERS--OUR NATION'S PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS--ARE COURAGEOUSLY AND VALIANTLY SAFEGUARDING OUR LIVES AND PROPERTY.

AND THEY ARE PUTTING THEIR LIVES ON THE LINE EVERY DAY. AND MANY HAVE SACRIFICED THEIR LIVES TO PROTECT OURS. IN 1961, 37 POLICEMEN WERE KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY. ONE DECADE LATER THE NUMBER HAS NEARLY QUADRUPLED TO 126. IN THE PAST TEN YEARS OVER 700 POLICEMEN AND 44 FIREMEN WERE KILLED BY VIOLENT ATTACKS. AND NOW THIS HONOR ROLE HAS BEEN JOINED BY PRISON GUARDS--IN 1970-1971, 18 OF THESE BRAVE AMERICANS WERE KILLED.

AND THE NATION'S TRAGEDY IS FLORIDA'S TRAGEDY. IN THE FISCAL YEAR 1971 THREE POLICEMEN WERE KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY--IN LEON COUNTY, IN PAHOKEE, AND IN MIAMI. IN THE SOUTH ATLANTIC REGION, THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CHIEFS OF POLICE REPORTS THAT 16 OFFICERS WERE KILLED IN THIS PERIOD. AND 275 WERE INJURED. I SAY TO YOU THIS SLAUGHTER MUST STOP. I BELIEVE THAT SOMETHING CAN BE DONE TO STOP THE KILLING OF POLICEMEN, FIREMEN AND PRISON GUARDS.

TONIGHT, BEFORE THE NATIONAL CRIME FORUM, I WANT TO ANNOUNCE MY INTENTION TO INTRODUCE LEGISLATION TO MAKE THE MURDER OR ATTEMPTED MURDER OF STATE AND LOCAL POLICEMEN, FIREMEN, AND PRISON GUARDS A FEDERAL OFFENSE.

THESE PEACE OFFICERS, THESE MEN WHO DAILY PUT THEIR LIVES ON THE LINE FOR EACH AND ALL OF US, DESERVE FEDERAL PROTECTION. WE MUST--AND WE CAN--DO MORE TO PROTECT THEM FROM BULLETS OF HATE, FEAR, AND COWARDICE. I SAY AGAIN--THIS SLAUGHTER MUST STOP. WE MUST REMEMBER THAT BEFORE KIDNAPPING WAS MADE A FEDERAL OFFENSE, THIS CRIME WAS REACHING CATASTROPHIC PROPORTIONS, WITH ALMOST 300 KIDNAPPINGS IN 1931 ALONE. SUBSEQUENTLY, KIDNAPPINGS HAVE AVERAGED ONLY 28 PER YEAR---A STARTLING AND GRATIFYING REVERSAL.

A SIMILAR REVERSAL MAY BE ACHIEVED WITH THE USE OF FEDERAL INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION OF CASES INVOLVING ATTACKS ON PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS.

A FEDERAL ROLE MEANS THE IMMEDIATE AND TOTAL COMMITMENT OF THE VAST RESOURCES OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION. IT MEANS THE FULL COMMITMENT OF THE FEDERAL JUDICIAL PROCESS. IT MEANS THAT NO MATTER WHERE THESE CRIMES MAY TAKE PLACE--FROM THE SMALLEST TOWN TO THE LARGEST CITY--THE FBI WILL BE INVOLVED IN APPREHENDING THE CRIMINAL. WE EXPECT MUCH FROM OUR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS--AND THEY DELIVER. IN RETURN, WE MUST DO ALL WE CAN TO INSURE THEIR SECURITY WHILE THEY PERFORM THEIR VITAL TASKS.

WHILE WE INCREASE PROTECTION FOR THESE OFFICERS, WE MUST EQUALLY INCREASE THE SENSE OF SECURITY OF THEIR FAMILIES.

WE CAN AND MUST PROVIDE FEDERAL LIFE INSURANCE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND FIREFIGHTING PERSONNEL SIMILAR TO THAT AVAILABLE TO MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES. I AM ONE OF THE MAJOR CO-SPONSORS OF THE VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT OF 1972, WHICH WILL PROVIDE UP TO \$60,000 OF NO-COST LIFE INSURANCE TO OUR PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS.

WE CANNOT LET THE FAMILIES OF POLICEMEN, FIREMEN, AND PRISON GUARDS WHO ARE KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY CONTINUE TO BE FORGOTTEN BY OUR GOVERNMENT.

OUR GOVERNMENT MUST NOT FORGET THE MANY OTHER VICTIMS OF CRIME IN AMERICA. WE CANNOT PROVIDE JUSTICE FOR AMERICANS WITHOUT PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO THOSE AMERICANS WHO SUFFER FROM CRIMES.

WE MUST RECOGNIZE OUR CLEAR OBLIGATION TO EVERY CITIZEN IN NEED WHO IS AN INNOCENT VICTIM OF VIOLENCE. WE MUST RECOGNIZE--AND NEVER FORGET--THAT GOVERNMENT EXISTS FOR THE PEOPLE. IN OUR EFFORTS TO STRENGTHEN THE MEANS BY WHICH WE IDENTIFY, APPREHEND, AND CONVICT THE CRIMINAL, WE MUST NOT FORGET THE VICTIM. FOR IT IS IN HIS INTEREST THAT OUR SYSTEM OF JUSTICE MUST OPERATE.

WE MUST HAVE A NEW ERA OF PERSONAL SECURITY IN THE UNITED STATES. THE VICTIMS OF CRIME ACT IS PART OF THAT NEW ERA.

WE MUST FOLLOW THE EXAMPLE OF OTHER NATIONS AND PROVIDE FINANCIAL RELIEF TO VICTIMS OF VIOLENT CRIMES. WHAT HAPPENS TO AN INJURED PERSON, LEFT HALF-DEAD IN THE STREET? IF SOMEONE CALLS AN AMBULANCE, THE VICTIM MUST PAY FOR IT. IF HE GOES TO THE HOSPITAL, HE LOSES HIS SALARY FOR THE TIME LOST.

WE MUST HAVE A NATIONAL POLICY OF COMPENSATION FOR THE VICTIMS, OR FAMILIES OF VICTIMS, OF CRIMINAL ACTS.

ALL AMERICANS WHO ARE INNOCENT VICTIMS OF LAWLESSNESS MUST BE COMPENSATED FOR THEIR INJURIES AND LOSS.

THE NOTION THAT SOCIETY HAS AN OBLIGATION TO HELP MEET THE FINANCIAL NEEDS OF CRIME VICTIMS IS AN OLD ONE. YET OUR GOVERNMENT HAS NEVER MET OUR OBLIGATION. IT IS A MATTER OF GOOD CONSCIENCE AND SIMPLE JUSTICE.
