STATEMENT FOR AIRPORT PRESS CONFERENCE

MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN MARCH 15, 1972 TWO MONTHS AGO I DECLARED MY CANDIDACY FOR THE DEMOCRATIC NOMINATION FOR PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

TODAY I HAVE COME BACK TO WISCONSIN TO TAKE MY CAMPAIGN TO THE PEOPLE OF THIS STATE.

I HAVE LISTENED AND TALKED WITH PEOPLE FROM ALL WALKS
OF LIFE IN THE MANY STATES I HAVE VISITED.

I AM CONVINCED THAT THE MAIN ISSUE IN 1972--ALL ACROSS

AMERICA--IS A REPUBLICAN ADMINISTRATION'S DISREGARD OF

"WE THE PEOPLE. . ."

THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN NEED JOBS.

THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN NEED DECENT INCOME FROM THEIR FARMS.

THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN NEED A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT AND GOOD HOUSING.

THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN NEED TAX REFORM AND TAX JUSTICE.

THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN NEED SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS.

AND THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN NEED BETTER EDUCATION FOR

THEIR CHILDREN.

THE CATALOGUE OF UNMET NEEDS FOR AMERICA IS TOO LONG

FOR A NATION THAT SHOULD BE PROSPERING. AND IT IS TOO LONG

FOR AN AMERICA WHERE THE NEEDS OF ALL THE PEOPLE MUST COME

BEFORE THE DESIRES OF THE WEALTHY, THE PRIVILEGED FEW AND

THE POWERFUL.

I AM COMMITTED TO SEE THAT THE VOICES OF THE PEOPLE ARE HEARD.

I AM COMMITTED TO MEETING UNMET NEEDS. I AM COMMITTED
TO PROVIDING FAIR TREATMENT AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY FOR ALL
AMERICANS.

THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN KNOW HUBERT HUMPHREY WELL.

I AM AT HOME IN THE BADGER STATE. FOR MANY YEARS WORKING

AND FARM FAMILIES OF WISCONSIN AS WELL AS THE PEOPLE OF

MINNESOTA WERE MY CONSTITUENTS. I HAVE SERVED BOTH WELL.

AS I TAKE MY CAMPAIGN ALL ACROSS THIS STATE--FROM
KENOSHA TO SUPERIOR--I WANT TO BRING THE MESSAGE THAT THE
PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT MUST GET ON WITH THE WORK OF BUILDING
A BETTER AMERICA.

AND I KNOW WHAT WE MUST DO TO RESTORE A UNITY OF PURPOSE -- A SENSE OF COMMITMENT WHICH WE HAVE LOST.

WE MUST HAVE A RECONCILIATION OF OUR DIFFERENCES,

A REBUILDING OF OUR SOCIETY AND A REBIRTH OF OUR SPIRIT.

I PLEDGE TO THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN THAT I WILL CONDUCT
A CAMPAIGN AS I HAVE DONE IN FLORIDA--A CAMPAIGN PEOPLE CAN
TRUST AND BELIEVE IN. I WILL CONDUCT A CAMPAIGN OF ISSUES-NOT PERSONALITIES. ONE OF PROGRAMS TO SOLVE PROBLEMS--NOT
PROMISES TO RAISE FALSE HOPES.
