- The audience will want a Q. & A. -- and will probably ask questions on Vietnam.
- The economic issue -- kids without jobs (statistics are in the text) is a major concern.
- 3. The environment issue is a hot one for the students -- a brief reference is made to it in the text.

I AM DEEPLY GRATEFUL THAT I HAVE BEEN CHOSEN AS YOUR MAN OF THE YEAR FOR 1972--I JUST HOPE IT'S A GOOD OMEN OF THINGS TO COME.

AND I AM GREATLY PLEASED THAT THIS AWARD IS FROM A YOUTH GROUP. THROUGHOUT MY CAREER I HAVE MADE THE CONCERNS OF YOUTH A HIGH PRIORITY IN MY ACTIVITIES:

--I WAS THE AUTHOR OF THE STUDENT LOAN PROGRAM UNDER THE NATIONAL DEFENSE EDUCATION ACT.

--I WAS THE AUTHOR OF THE PEACE CORPS AND THE JOB CORPS.

--AND, WHEN I WAS VICE PRESIDENT, I SERVED AS CHAIRMAN OF THE PRESIDENT'S COUNCIL ON YOUTH OPPORTUNITY. BUT ALL THIS IS PAST HISTORY. I'M A TEACHER AND I KNOW IT'S GOOD TO STUDY HISTORY--BUT IT'S BETTER TO MAKE HISTORY.

THE FUTURE IS NOW--AND TODAY IS ALL WE HAVE TO WORK WITH--TODAY IS TRULY THE FIRST DAY OF THE REST OF YOUR LIFE. WE MUST MAKE THE MOST OF IT.

AS YOUNG AMERICANS IN A YOUNG NATION, YOU MUST BEGIN TO ASK WHAT ARE WE AND WHERE ARE WE GOING?

THERE ISN'T A CORNER OF THIS COUNTRY, THERE ISN'T A NATION ON THIS GLOBE WHERE YOU CAN ESCAPE THE INEVITABILITY OF FUTURE CHANGE. LET ME ASK:

ARE YOU CONTENT THAT 70 PERCENT OF THE AMERICAN POPULATION NOW LIVES ON LESS THAN 2 PERCENT OF THE LAND?

DO YOU THINK OUR CITIES CAN SURVIVE IF THIS TREND CONTINUES AND OUR POPULATION WHICH IS NOW 208 MILLION INCREASES TO 320 MILLION BY THE YEAR 2000?

HAVE YOU ASKED WHETHER RURAL AMERICA CAN SURVIVE AS A VIABLE ECONOMIC ENTITY WHEN 650,000 RURAL AMERICANS LEAVE THE COUNTRYSIDE EACH YEAR ABANDONING THEIR FARMS AND LEAVING SMALL TOWNS TO DIE?

ARE YOU PLEASED THAT FEW AMERICANS CAN AFFORD TO BE SICK BECAUSE HOSPITAL COSTS HAVE RISEN 122 PERCENT IN THE LAST 10 YEARS? DO YOU THINK WE CAN HALT AIR, NOISE AND WATER POLLUTION--NOW THREATS TO OUR HEALTH AND LIVES--AND STILL EXPAND OUR INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION AND MEET CONSUMER DEMANDS?

HOW ARE WE GOING TO PROVIDE THE 25 MILLION NEW JOBS NEEDED IN JUST 9 YEARS WHEN OVER 5 1/2 MILLION AMERICANS ARE UNEMPLOYED TODAY?

THESE ARE JUST A FEW OF THE QUESTIONS YOU MUST FACE NOW. THERE IS ONE MORE QUESTION I WOULD LIKE TO ASK:

AS YOUNG, AMERICANS IN HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGE, WHAT ARE YOU GOING TO DO TOMORROW ABOUT THESE PROBLEMS AND THE FUTURE?

IT SEEMS TO ME THAT WE ARE TALKING ABOUT PUBLIC POLICIES FOR THE FUTURE AND ATTITUDES OF NATIONAL LEADERS. I BELIEVE THAT YOUNG AMERICANS NO LONGER HAVE TO PLEAD, PERSUADE OR INFLUENCE POLICIES OR POLITICAL LEADERS.

YOUNG AMERICANS NOW HAVE THE VOTE.

YOU NOW HAVE POTENTIAL POWER BECAUSE THERE WILL BE 25 MILLION NEW VOTERS IN 1972. IN THE GREAT STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA THERE WILL BE CLOSE TO 900,000 ELIGIBLE NEW VOTERS.

I USE THE PHRASE POTENTIAL POWER BECAUSE POWER COMES

YOUNG PEOPLE IN AMERICA TODAY ARE NOT ORGANIZED.

THE BANKERS ARE ORGANIZED. THE FARMERS ARE ORGANIZED. THE UNIONS ARE ORGANIZED. THE ELDERLY ARE ORGANIZED.

WHY NOT THE YOUNG?

I'VE BEEN IN POLITICS LONG ENOUGH TO TELL YOU THAT FEW THINGS WILL FALL INTO YOUR LAPS BY MERELY WANTING OR WISHING THEM.

YOU MUST DEMONSTRATE POLITICAL MUSCLE AND FIGHT FOR WHAT YOU WANT AND WHAT YOU BELIEVE IS RIGHT.

STUDENTS MUST BEGIN TO THINK IN TERMS OF HOW TO CHANGE POLICIES AND ELECT LEADERS WHO WILL CARE ABOUT THE NEEDS OF ALL OF THE 93 MILLION AMERICANS UNDER 25 YEARS OF AGE. 7

I BELIEVE YOUR LIST OF IMMEDIATE GOALS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE IN AMERICA SHOULD INCLUDE:

--A FREE NUTRITIOUS LUNCH FOR ALL SCHOOL CHILDREN REGARDLESS OF INCOME.

--FEDERAL AND STATE PROGRAMS OF CHILD CARE FOR NEW BORN AND THE VERY YOUNG IN NEED.

--JOBS NOW FOR UNEMPLOYED TEENAGERS, THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE FOR WHITE TEENAGERS IS 13.5 PERCENT, BLACK TEENAGE UNEMPLOYMENT IS AT A SCANDALOUS LEVEL OF 33,5 PERCENT.

--AN END TO ILLITERACY IN AMERICA.

--EXPANDED VOCATIONAL AND MANPOWER TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR YOUNG PEOPLE. --JOBS FOR THE RETURNING VIETNAM VETERANS. THEIR UNEMPLOYMENT RATE NOW STANDS AT 12 PERCENT.

--JOBS FOR YOUNG TEACHERS, LAWYERS, ENGLISH MAJORS AND COLLEGE EDUCATED PEOPLE IN GENERAL; UNEMPLOYED PHD'S ARE EVERYWHERE.

--A NATIONAL SYSTEM OF VOTER REGISTRATION FOR FEDERAL ELECTIONS.

--LAST -- PERHAPS MOST IMPORTANT -- PEACE NOW IN VIETNAM. THE GREATEST PURSUIT OF MANKIND IS PEACE. AND, AS POPE PAUL HAS SAID, DEVELOPMENT IS THE NEW PEACE -- AND DEVELOPMENT MUST BE HERE AT HOME AS WELL AS ABROAD. IF WE ARE TO HAVE A PEACEFUL WORLD, WE MUST START HERE. IF WE CAN'T GET ALONG WITH EACH OTHER, WHAT MAKES YOU THINK WE CAN GET ALONG WITH THE WORLD? AND PEACE IS NOT JUST THE ABSENCE OF VIOLENCE AND WAR, IT IS THE PRESENCE OF A HARMONY OF LIFE.

I WANT AMERICA TO BE KNOWN FOR OUR COMPASSION AND UNDERSTANDING -- NOT FOR OUR WEALTH AND POWER. BUT WE MUST BEWARE OF TWO WORDS -- "HATE" AND "YESTERDAY." HATE IS A CANCER, AND YESTERDAY IS GONE. AND WE MUST REMEMBER TWO OTHER WORDS -- "LOVE" AND "TOMORROW." LOVE IS UNDERSTANDING, TOLERANCE, AND HUMAN DIGNITY. AND TOMORROW IS THE FUTURE --AND THAT'S WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT. EACH GENERATION HELPS TO BUILD THIS COUNTRY--YOU MUST LEARN NEW WAYS TO BUILD AND CLEAR AWAY THE DEBRIS.

WE MUST FORGE AHEAD -- TO BUILD A SOCIETY OF JUSTICE AND DECENCY. A SOCIETY WHERE THE OLD ARE CARED FOR, WHERE THE YOUNG ARE GIVEN OPPORTUNITY, AND WHERE THOSE IN THE FULLNESS OF LIFE HAVE A CHANCE TO MAKE A CONTRIBUTION TO THE BUILDING OF A BETTER SOCIETY.

THAT'S MY MESSAGE TO YOU AND LET ME TELL YOU -- IT'S IN YOUR HANDS. UNLESS YOU MAKE THE BEST OF IT, YOU'LL GET THE WORST OF IT. WE MUST MOVE FORWARD -- OR WE WILL ONLY MOVE BACK. WE MUST ACHIEVE OUR PROMISE AND OUR DREAM --TO MAKE AMERICA THE LAST BEST HOPE ON EARTH.
