The way things stand now, you will speak after McGovern and before Muskie. It is to be regretted that the rich and powerful too often bend the acts of government to their selfish purposes ... Every man is equally entitled to protection by law; but when the laws undertake to add ... artificial distinctions, to grant titles, gratuities, and exclusive privileges, to make the rich richer and the potent more powerful, the humble members of society -- the farmers, mechanics, and laborers -- who have neither the time nor the means of securing like favors to themselves, have a right to complain of the injustice of their government.

The lines are still sharply drawn between the Democratic party -party of the people and the Republican Party -· party of privilege.

Today under the Republican Administration there is government of the many, by the few and for the benefit of the special interests.
