The event is being co-sponsored with the University Forum, so the audience will be from all segments of the university community.

You will definitely have a couple of questions on Israel and the Middle East -- and most likely several on Vietnam.

THROUGHOUT THE WORLD WILL BE CELEBRATING THE 24TH

ANNIVERSARY OF THE INDEPENDENCE OF THE STATE OF ISPAEL.

IN THOSE 24 YEARS, ISRAEL HAS BECOME A SYMBOL OF COURAGE

AND HOPE TO MILLIONS OF AMERICANS OF ALL FAITHS AND CREEDS.

NO NATION HAS REMAINED AS STEADFASTLY LOYAL TO THE PRINCIPLES

OF HUMAN FREEDOM AND DEMOCRACY WHILE FACING SUCH OVERWHELMING

CHALLENGES -- AS ISRAEL.

SADLY ENOUGH, THE UNITED STATES CONTINUES TO REFUSE

TO ACKNOWLEDGE CERTAIN FUNDAMENTAL REALITIES CREATED BY

AN INDEPENDENT ISRAEL.

AFTER 24 YEARS OUR GOVERNMENT STILL REFUSES

TO ACKNOWLEDGE THE REALITY OF A JEWISH JERUSALEM. AND WE

COMPOUND THIS REFUSAL BY CONDEMNING ISRAEL'S REBUILDING

AND REUNIFICATION OF THIS SACRED CITY.

WE SHOULD WELCOME A UNITED JERUSALEM IN WHICH THE SHRINES AND HOLY PLACES OF ALL FAITHS ARE TREATED WITH RESPECT. WE SHOULD ACKNOWLEDGE THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF ISRAEL AND ITS PEOPLE TO THE CAUSE OF HUMAN DIGNITY AND FREEDOM.

ACCORDINGLY, I STATE TO YOU TODAY THAT WHATEVER MY ROLE
MAY BE IN AMERICAN PUBLIC LIFE NEXT YEAR, I SHALL JOURNEY
TO JERUSALEM TO JOIN IN THE CELEBRATION OF ISRAEL'S

25TH ANNIVERSARY.

THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES HAS RECENTLY

VISITED WITH MANY OF OUR ALLIES AND EVEN OUR MAJOR

ADVERSARIES, BUT HE HAS NEVER FOUND TIME TO VISIT OUR

MOST LOYAL FRIEND IN THE MIDDLE EAST. IT'S TIME THE

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES VISITED THE STATE OF ISRAEL.

I LOOK FORWARD TO CELEBRATING ISRAEL'S 25TH

ANNIVERSARY WITH LEADERS AND PEOPLE OF ISRAEL IN THEIR

CAPITAL CITY.
