--I WAS THE AUTHOR OF THE PEACE CORPS AND THE JOB CORPS.
I DEVELOPED THE IDEA OF THE PEACE CORPS IN 1960.

--I WAS THE AUTHOR OF THE TEST BAN TREATY--I WAS ONE
OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S REPRESENTATIVES IN MOSCOW. WHEN
THE PRESIDENT SIGNED THE TREATY, HE TURNED TO ME AND SAID:
"HUBERT, THIS PEN IS YOURS, BECAUSE THIS IS YOUR TREATY,"
