ESSEX COUNTY DEMOCRATIC VICTORY DINNER

Newark, New Jersey May 17, 1972

LET ME ASK YOU THIS QUESTION:

WHAT DO WE WANT FROM OUR PRESIDENT?

WE WANT A PRESIDENT WHO IS COMPASSIONATE, WHO IS UNDERSTANDING, WHO CARES ABOUT YOU AND WHERE YOU LIVE. WE WANT A LEADER WHO IS PRESIDENT OF ALL THE PEOPLE. RICHARD NIXON HAS FAILED TO BE PRESIDENT OF ALL THE PEOPLE.

THE PEOPLE OF NEW JERSEY AND THE PEOPLE ACROSS AMERICA DON'T WANT ANOTHER FOUR YEARS OF RICHARD NIXON. AND COME NOVEMBER, YOU'RE GOING TO SEE A VOTERS' REVOLT AGAINST HIM THAT'S GOING TO SWEEP HIM OUT OF OFFICE.

I PLEDGE A FAIR SOCIETY THAT USES THE PRODUCTIVE RESOURCES OF THIS NATION TO SOLVE THE NEEDS OF ALL THE

PEOPLE -- A SOCIETY THAT MAKES ALL THE PEOPLE THE BENEFICIARIES OF OUR WEALTH AND OUR RESOURCES, NOT THE VICTIMS OF RECESSION AND HARD TIMES.
