A NEW BILL OF RIGHTS FOR BLACK AMERICANS

*Reason for 800000  
unemployed  
Depression for blacks*

*Jobs - J.Corp!*

- THE RIGHT TO A JOB (Adult black unemployment nearly double white. Black teenage unemployment triple white. People do not want welfare--they want jobs.)
- THE RIGHT TO LIFE (Life expectancy for blacks: 60; whites: 67. 37 black babies die at birth--19 white babies die. 30 million Americans without health insur.--poor white & black.)
- THE RIGHT TO RAISE YOUR CHILDREN IN DECENCY (No more day care warehouses--no more latch-key children.)
- THE RIGHT TO EQUAL EDUCATION (Massive Fed. assistance--an end to illiteracy. Good education no matter where you live.)
- THE RIGHT TO A GOOD HOME (Decent homes to raise your children. I want to put real estate speculators, insurance companies and landlords that prey upon blacks out of business.)
- THE RIGHT TO A GOOD DIET (We can end hunger because we have the food--it's as simple as that.)
- THE RIGHT TO DRUG FREE STREETS (Let's get the pusher out of your neighborhood.)
- THE RIGHT TO PARTICIPATE (More blacks in government and politics. I pledge an administration with soul.) Soul
- THE RIGHT TO CONSUMER PROTECTION (An end to unfair business practices in your neighborhoods.)
- THE RIGHT TO BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY (I want to help black people make it up the business ladder. I know what owning a business means to a family.)
- THE RIGHT TO BE TREATED AS A PERSON (I want to begin a frontal assault on racism in America.)
- THE RIGHT TO BE BLACK (The fundamental right to discover your own heritage.)
